Dr. Yu Yongding is an Academician of the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences. Currently a member of Advisory Committee of National Planning of the National Development and Reform Committee of the People's Republic of China and the President of Pu Shang Foundation

Dr. Yu Yongding was the Director-General of the Institute of World Economics and Politics (1998-2009) and the President of the China Society of World Economy (2003-2011); member of the Monetary Policy Committee of the People's Bank of China (2004-2006); member of the Advisory Committee of Foreign Policy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2010-2014); member of Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference and member of the Committee of Foreign Affairs of the CPPCC (2013-2018).

Dr. Yu Yongding has served at various international organizations as member or advisor. Among them are UN commission of the Reform of the International Monetary and Financial System (Stiglitz commission); UN Committee of Development Policy; Council on International Monetary Reform (Brookings); UN High Level-Panel of Financial Accountability, Transparency and Integrity; Council of Global Governance of the World Economic Forum; Advisory Committee and Global Commission of the Institute for New Economic Thinking; Bretton Woods Committee; Academie Hassan II des Sciences et Techniques, Royaume du Maroc; Advisory Committee of IMF Asian and Pacific Department. He is also a columnist for Project Syndicate since 2010.

Dr. Yu Yongding born in 1948 in Nanjing. He graduated from Beijing School of Science and Technology of Chinese Academy in 1969 and worked as an electrician in Beijing Heavy Machinery Building Factory (1969-1979). He joined the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences as a junior fellow in 1979. He became Assistant Research Fellow in 1983, appointed as director of the section of theoretical studies in 1986, and promoted as Associate Research fellow in 1987. He left China for the University of Oxford in 1998 and returned to Chinese Academy of Social Science in 1994. He was appointed as Senior Fellow in 1995 and elected as Member of the Chinese Academy of Social Sciences in 2006

Dr. Yu Yongding received MA in economics from the Graduate School of Chinese Academy of Social Sciences in 1983 and D.Phil. in economics from the University of Oxford in 1994.

Dr. Yu Yongding's research areas include macroeconomics, international finance, the Chinese economy and World economics. He has published more than ten books and numerous papers and articles over 4 decades.
