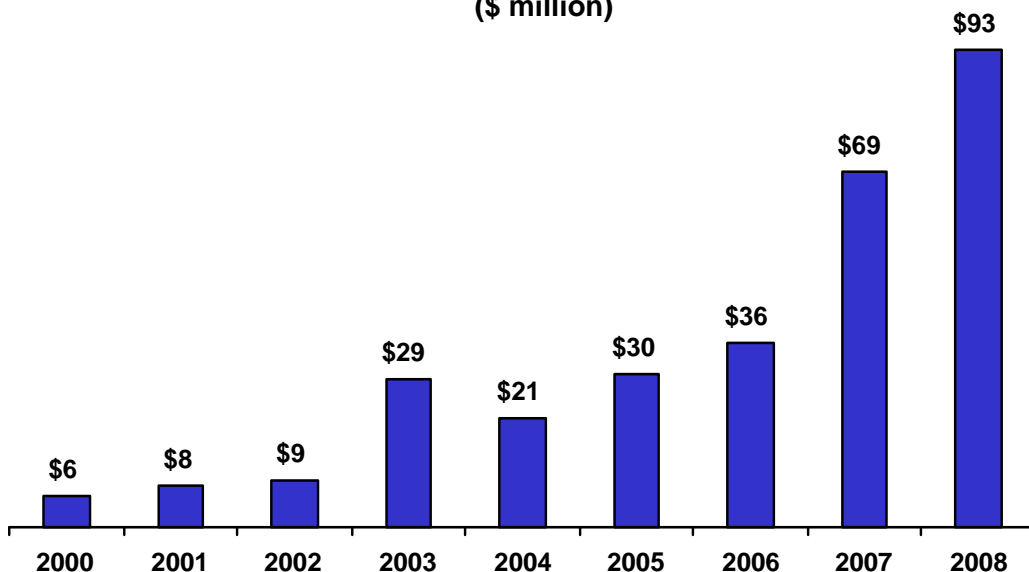




**Arkansas' 1st Congressional District: Exports to China
