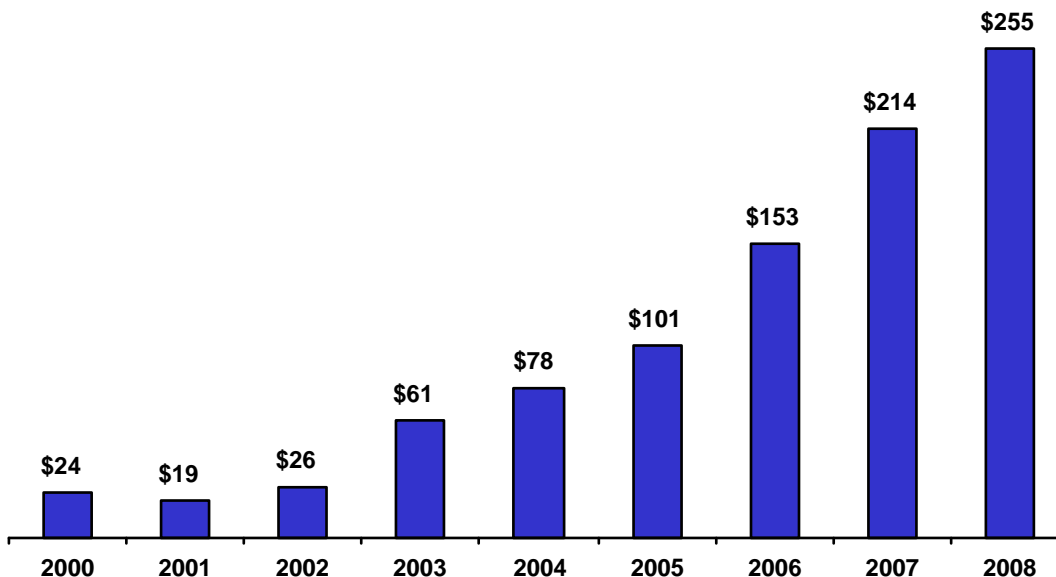




**Texas' 19th Congressional District: Exports to China

5. Primary Metal Manufacturing	\$718 million

**TX-19: Top Exports to China, 2008\***

1. Crop Production	\$177 million
2. Other Manufacturing	\$70 million
3. Processed Foods	\$4 million
4. Fabricated Metal Products	\$3 million
5. Animal Production	\$524,000
