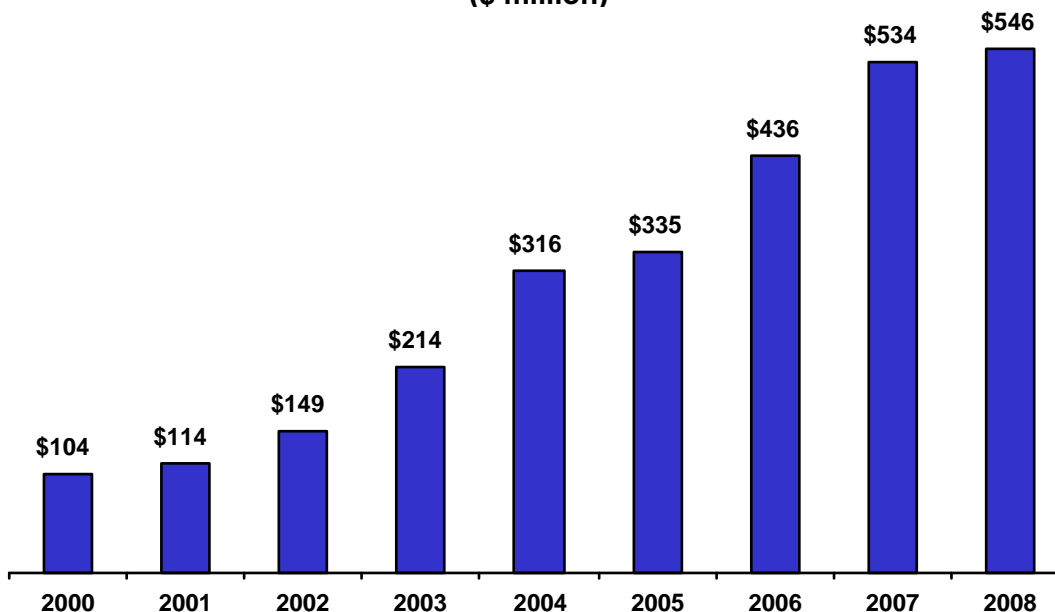




**Texas' 25th Congressional District: Exports to China

Texas' Top Exports to China, 2008

1. Chemicals	\$2.5 billion
2. Computers & Electronics	\$1.7 billion
3. Machinery (except Electrical)	\$1.1 billion
4. Crop Production	\$800 million
5. Primary Metal Manufacturing	\$718 million

TX-25: Top Exports to China, 2008*

1. Other Manufacturing	\$527 million
2. Crop Production	\$15 million
3. Fabricated Metal Products	\$2 million
4. Processed Foods	\$1 million
5. Publishing Industries	\$411,000

* The data for TX-25 reflect the combined exports of Bastrop, Caldwell, Colorado, Fayette, Gonzales, Hays, Lavaca, and Travis counties. The figures may understate the TX-25 district's total exports to China because county-specific information for some products (e.g., mining, forestry, fishing, and waste and scrap) is not available.
