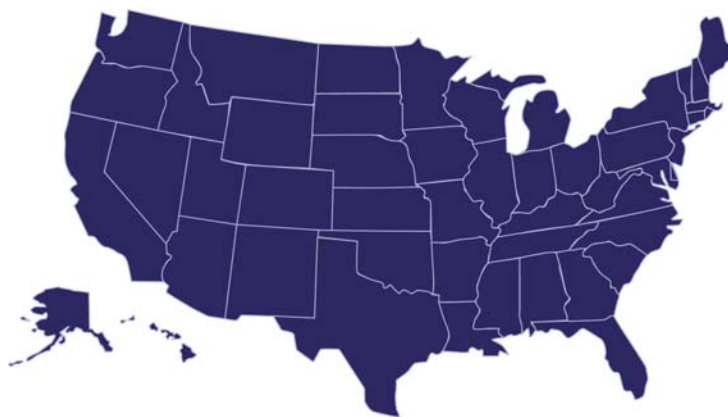

US Exports to China by State

2000-08





Executive Summary

The US-China Business Council (USCBC) each year releases analyses of US exports to China to better inform the policy debate about China trade and its impact on the US economy. This report details export growth by state; a second report will be issued soon showing export growth by congressional district.

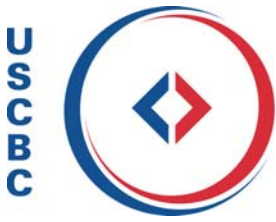
The key findings from this year's state export report:

- States all across the country increased exports to China during 2008, with 18 states exceeding \$1 billion in exports.
- China remains the third-largest export market for American-made products, behind only Canada and Mexico. US exports to China totaled \$71.5 billion in 2008. When US exports to Hong Kong are included, the total rises to \$93.1 billion.
- US exports to China grew nearly 10 percent in 2008 and are up 341 percent since 2000, the last full year before China entered the World Trade Organization and was required to reduce many trade barriers. In comparison, US exports to the rest of the world during this period grew 60 percent.
- The global recession is significantly impacting US exports—to China and to the rest of the world. US export growth was strong through the first three quarters of 2008 but declined significantly in the fourth quarter. USCBC expects that exports to China will continue to grow and outpace exports to other markets, once global economic growth returns.
- California continues to be the largest exporter of goods and commodities to China, followed by Washington, Texas, Louisiana, and New York. Key manufacturing states such as Ohio, Pennsylvania, Illinois, and Michigan also remained among the top 15 exporting states to China in 2008, as they were in 2007.
- Top product exports to China overall were computers and electronics (including components), agricultural products, chemicals, and transportation equipment.

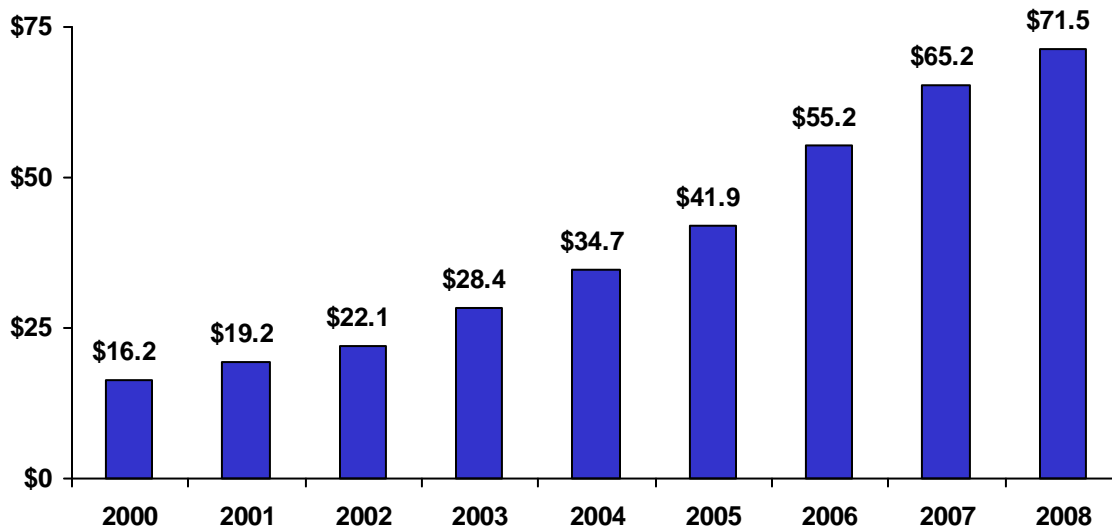


Notes on the 2000–08 Edition

- All data used for this and all previous editions of the report come from the US Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census. Prior to 2007, the Trade Statistics Express database operated by the US International Trade Administration was the basis for the report. The 2000–07 and 2000–08 editions are based on the Census Bureau’s USA Trade Online database. Any differences reflect minor Census Bureau data revisions.
- The US Census Bureau in early 2009 revised its national export figures back to 1990, causing minor variations in the historical datapoints used in the 2000–08 report.
- The national export totals include the export data for each state and for Washington, DC, US Territories, and “unassigned” exports.



US Exports to China (\$ billion)

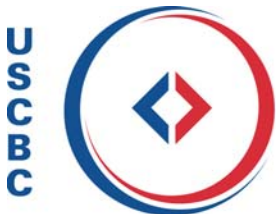

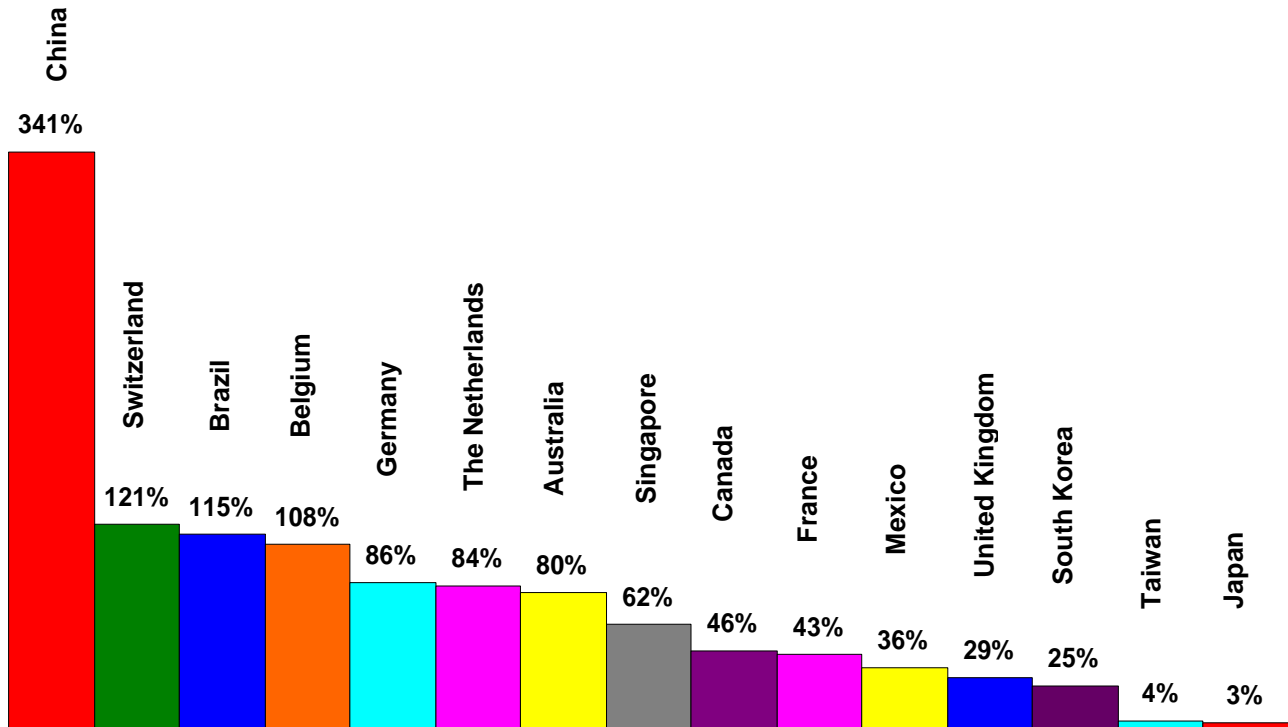

- China is not just a source of imports, but is also a large and growing market for US exports.
- China overtook Japan to become the third-largest US export market in 2007.
- When US exports to Hong Kong, a significant transit point for US goods destined for China, are combined with US exports to China, the 2008 export figure jumps to **\$93.1 billion**.
- As a buyer of US goods, China ranks behind only Canada and Mexico in 2008—two immediate neighbors with whom the United States has a free-trade agreement.

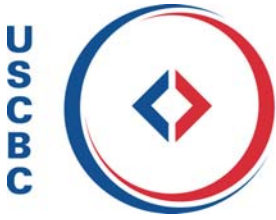


Growth in US Exports to Top 15 Markets, 2000–08

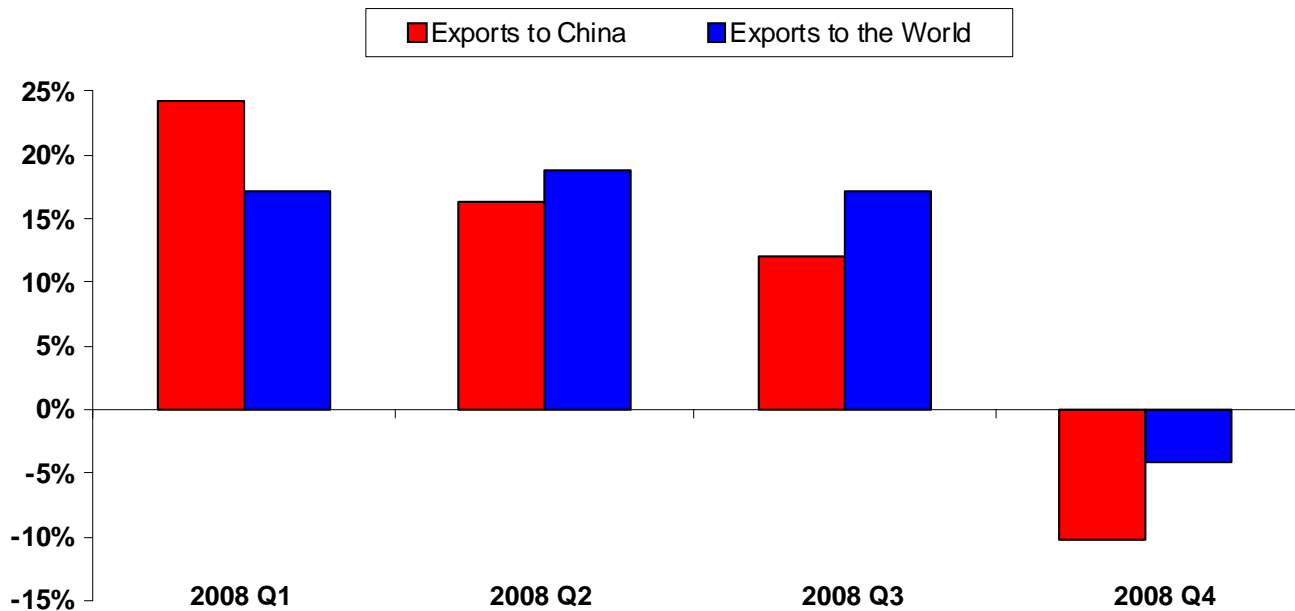


- US exports to China since 2000—the last full year before China’s entry into the World Trade Organization—have grown at a significantly faster rate than US exports to any other major export market. Computers and electronics, crop production, chemicals, and transportation equipment were among the largest US exports to China.
- The next fastest-growing major export market for US products over the past eight years was Switzerland, with iron and steel, chemicals, and manufactured commodities among the key US export products.
- Growth in the other top US export markets in the 2000-08 period—Canada, Mexico, Japan, and Germany—has been significantly slower.

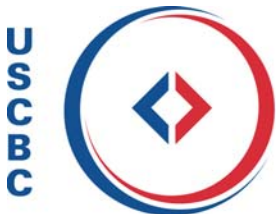


Impact of the Global Economic Downturn on US Exports to China and the World*



*Percentage change over same period in previous year

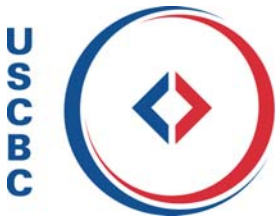
- Though export growth to China was nearly 10 percent for all of 2008, a quarterly breakdown shows that the global economic downturn is significantly impacting US exports to China—and to the rest of the world. US export growth to China and the world was strong through the first three quarters of 2008 but declined year-on-year in the fourth quarter.
- Once economic growth resumes, US exports to China should return to the previous pattern and outpace growth in exports to most other major markets. Between 2000 and 2008, US exports to China grew 341 percent, while US exports to the rest of the world grew 60 percent.



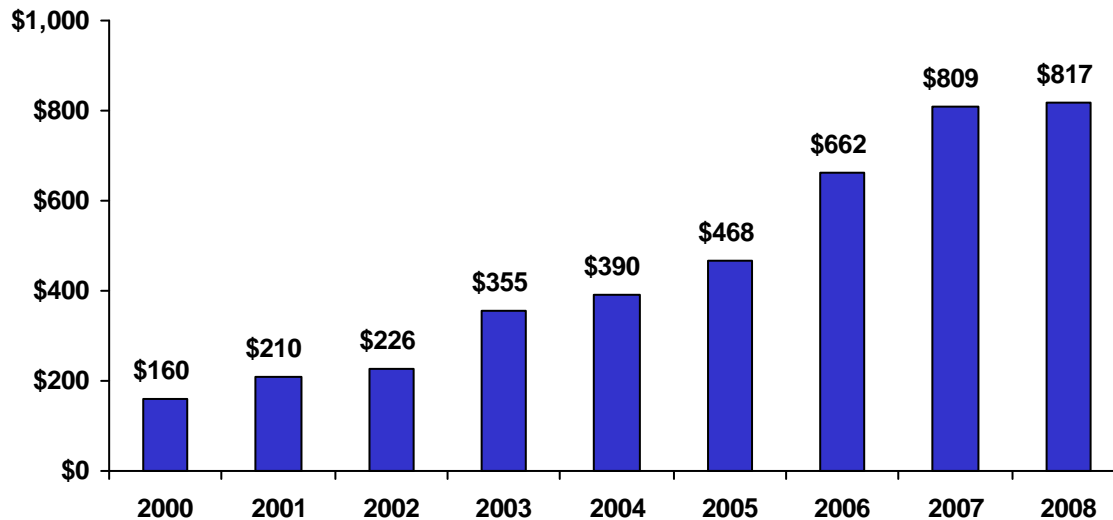

- Forty-eight states have registered at least triple-digit export growth to China since 2000, far outpacing exports to the rest of the world. Total US exports to China from 2000 to 2008 grew 341 percent, from \$16.2 billion to \$71.5 billion; total US exports to the rest of the world grew only 60 percent during this period.
- Total US exports to China grew 9.5 percent in 2008.
- Top state exporters to China in 2008 were California (\$11.0 billion), Washington (\$9.9 billion), Texas (\$8.4 billion), Louisiana (\$3.5 billion), and New York (\$2.8 billion).
- Eighteen states exported more than \$1 billion to China in 2008, and another 14 states exported more than \$500 million.
- The list of top 15 state exporters to China in 2008 includes states not usually thought of as benefitting from trade with China—Illinois, Georgia, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Tennessee, and Michigan.
- For the 2000–08 period, exports to China from 11 states—Nevada, Delaware, Utah, Hawaii, Vermont, Missouri, Montana, New Hampshire, Arkansas, Kentucky and Connecticut—grew faster than those from the top 15 exporters.
- The states with the largest growth in exports to China in 2008 compared to 2007 were Hawaii (159%), Oregon (72%), Oklahoma (62%), North Dakota (48%), and Montana (41%).



Alabama Exports to China (\$ million)

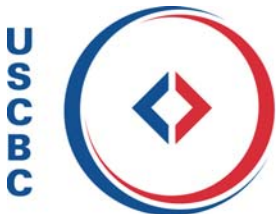

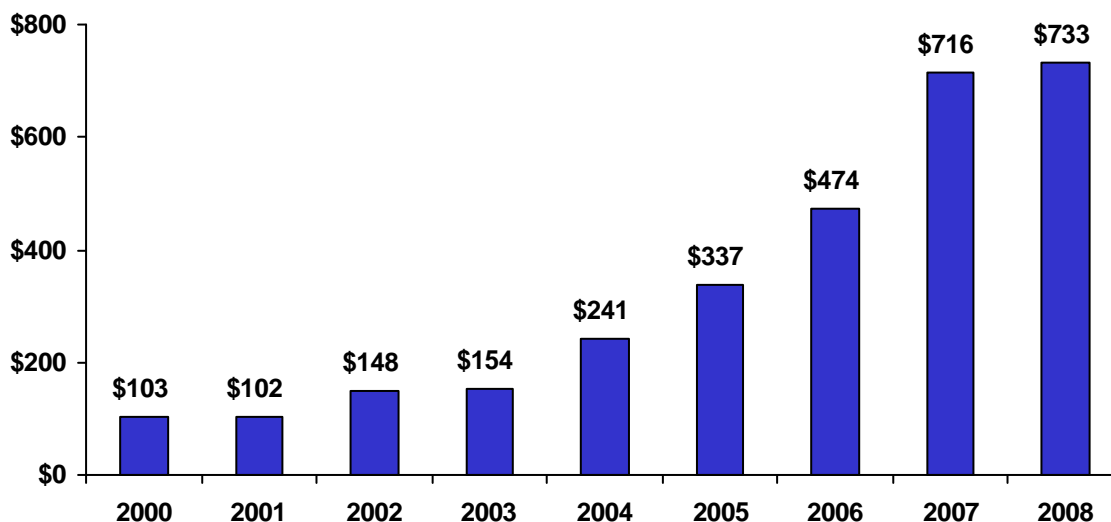

Alaska Exports to China (\$ million)

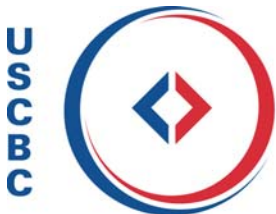

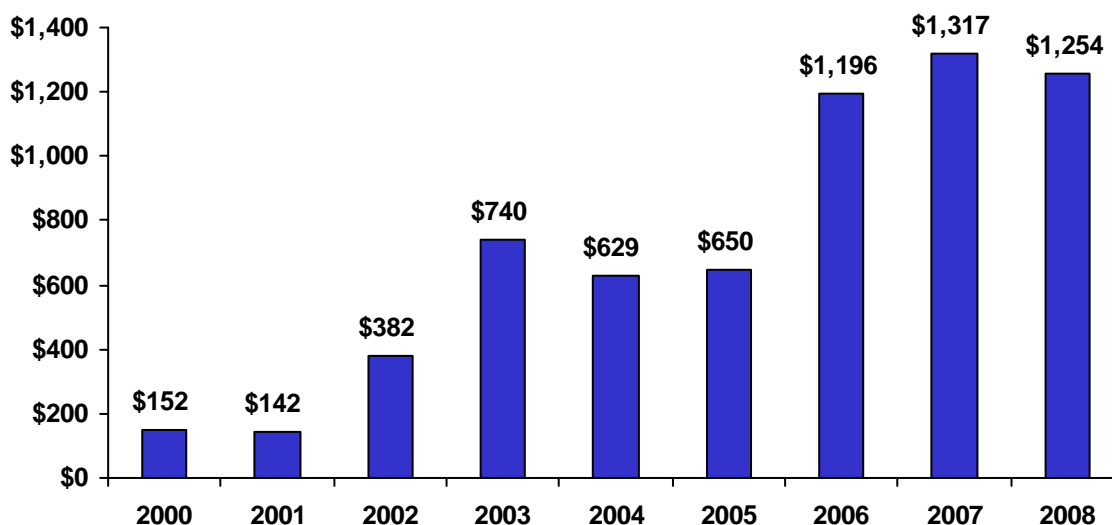

Arizona Exports to China (\$ million)

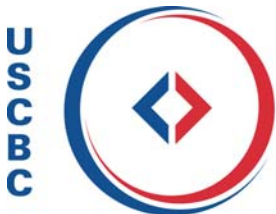

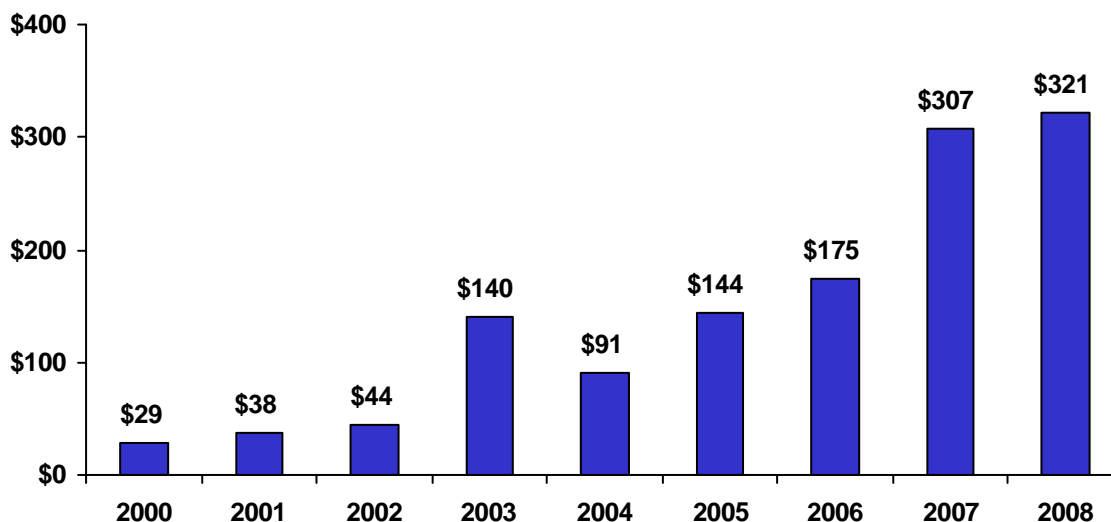

Arkansas Exports to China (\$ million)

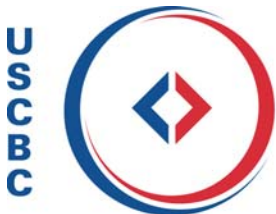

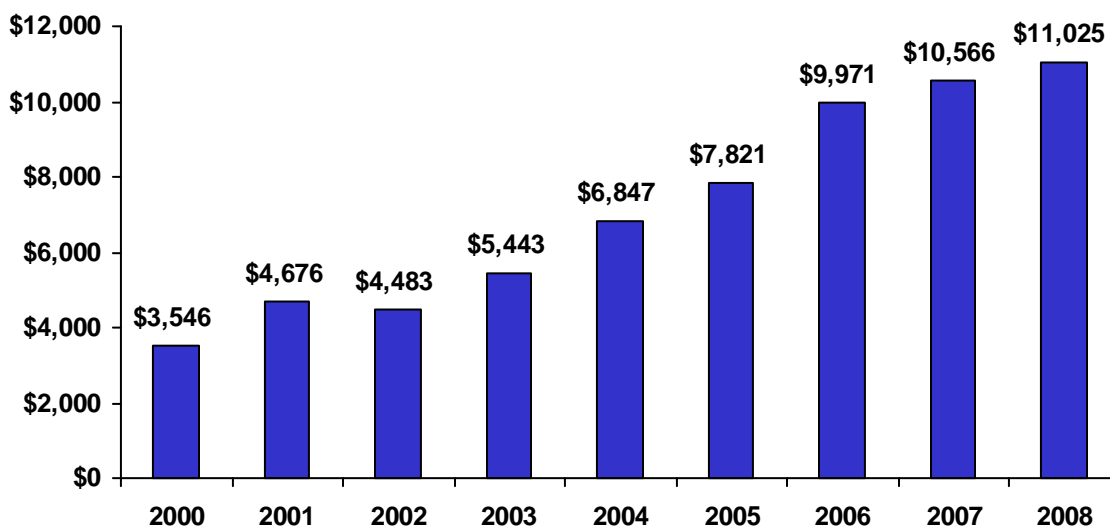

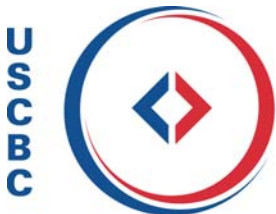

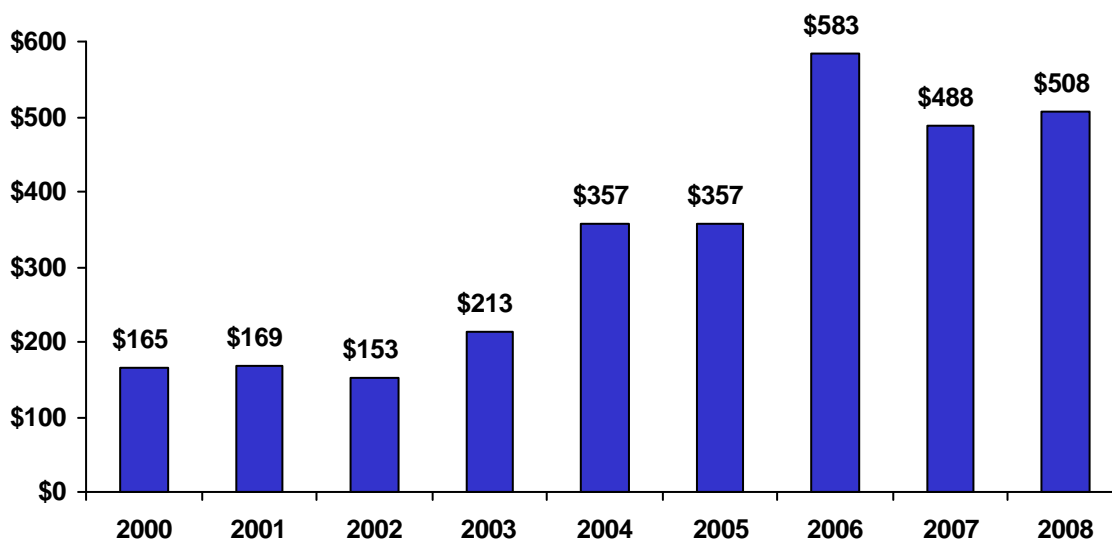

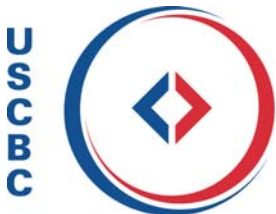

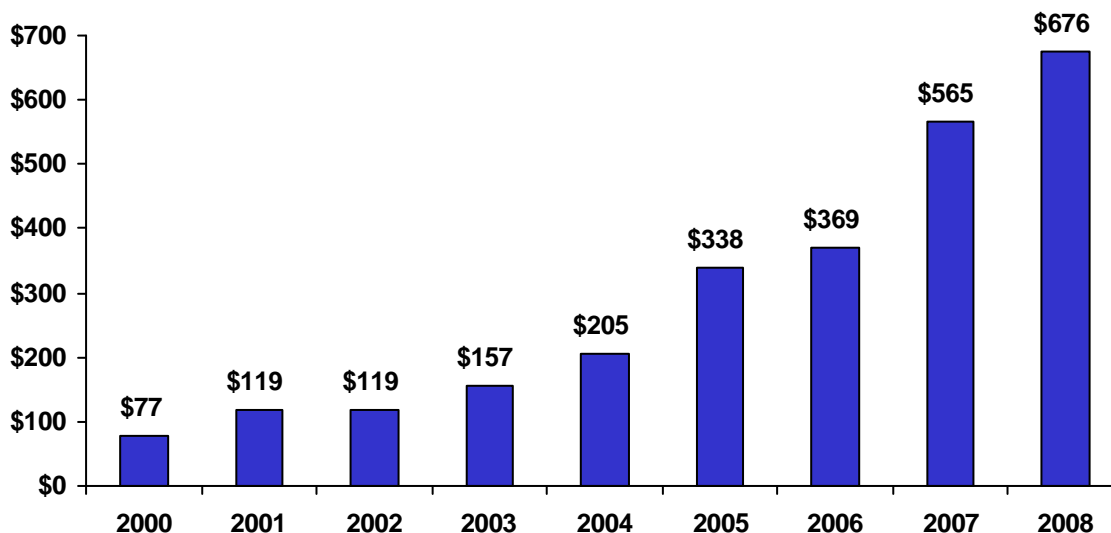

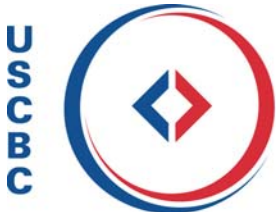

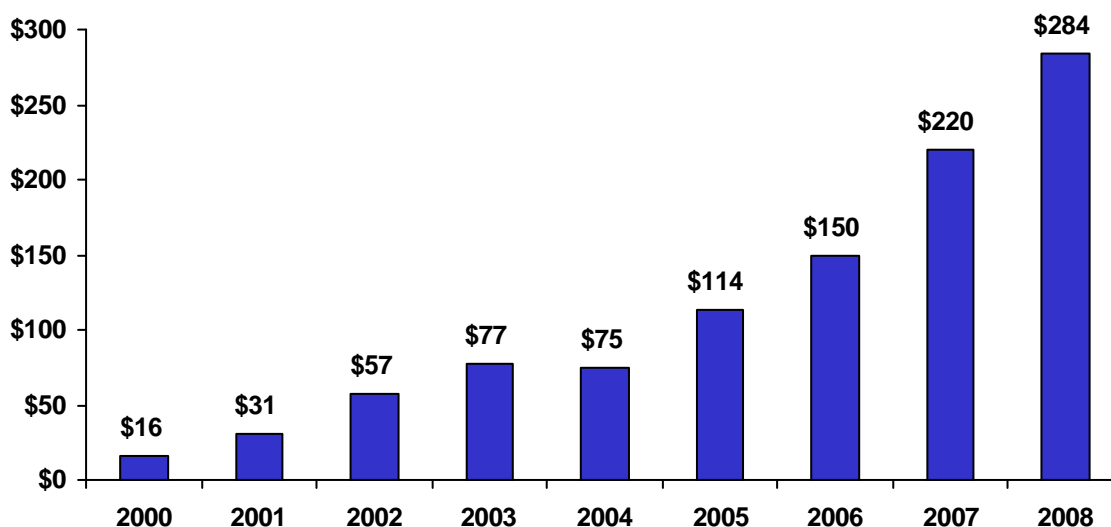

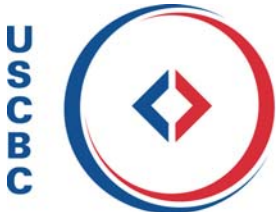

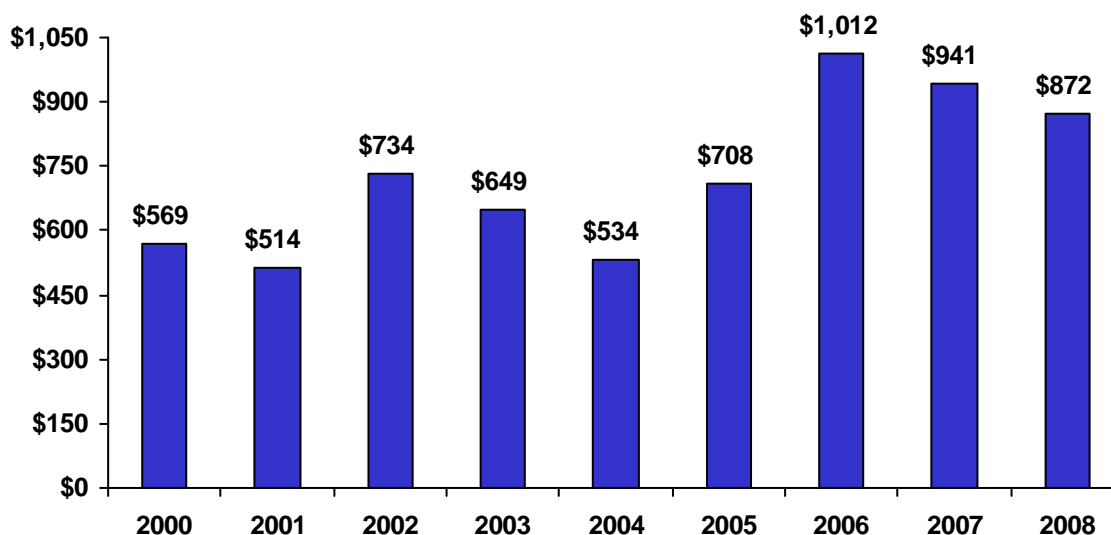

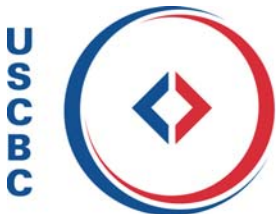

Georgia Exports to China (\$ million)

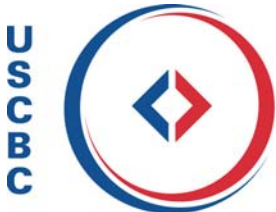

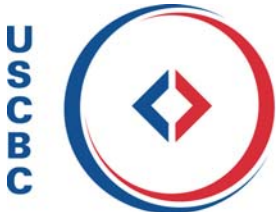

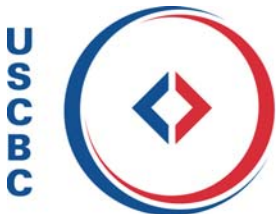

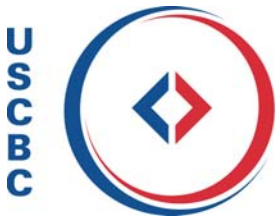

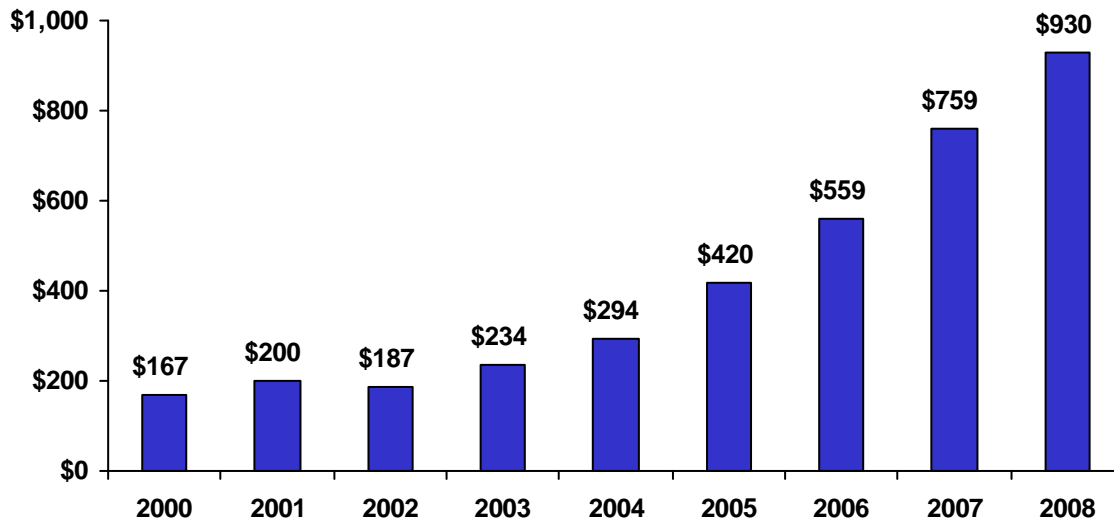

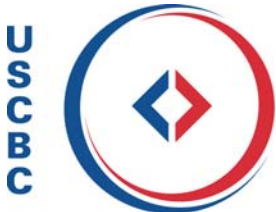

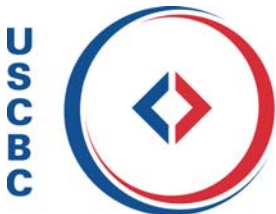

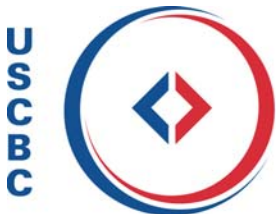

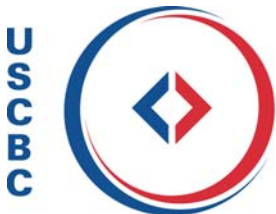

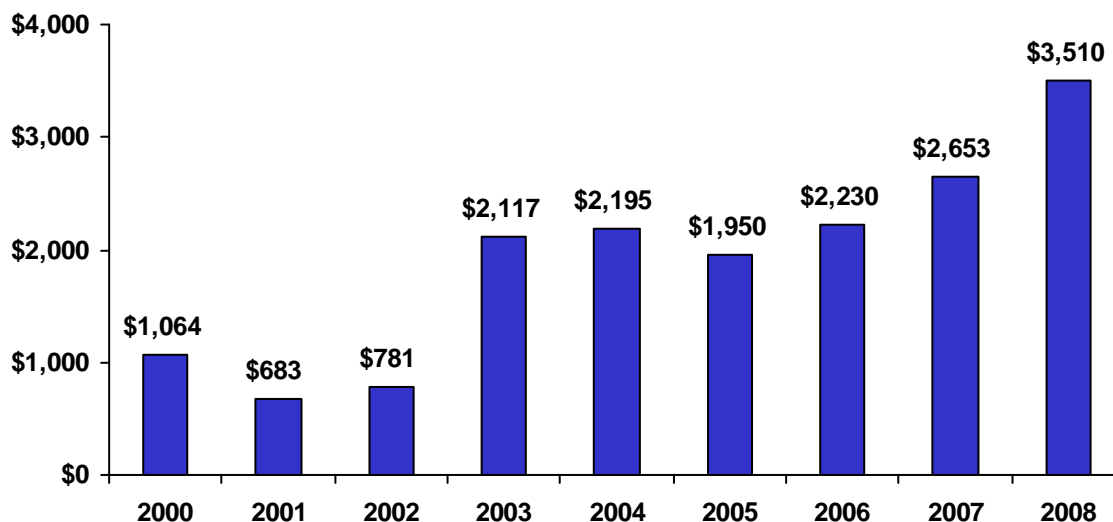

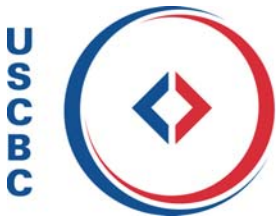

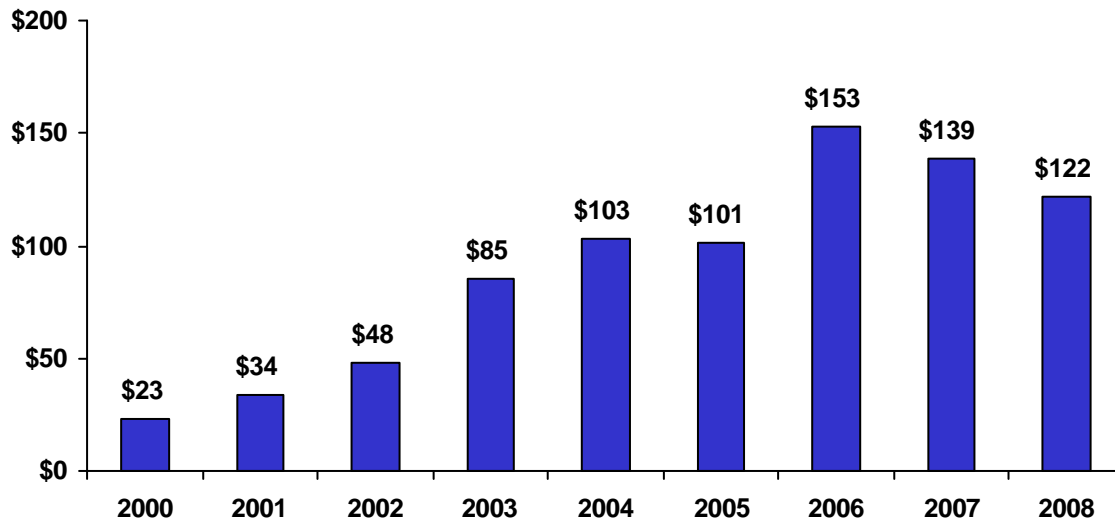

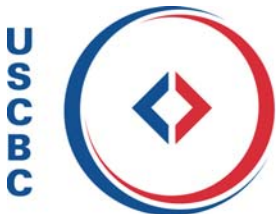

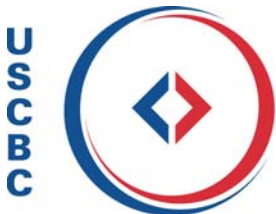

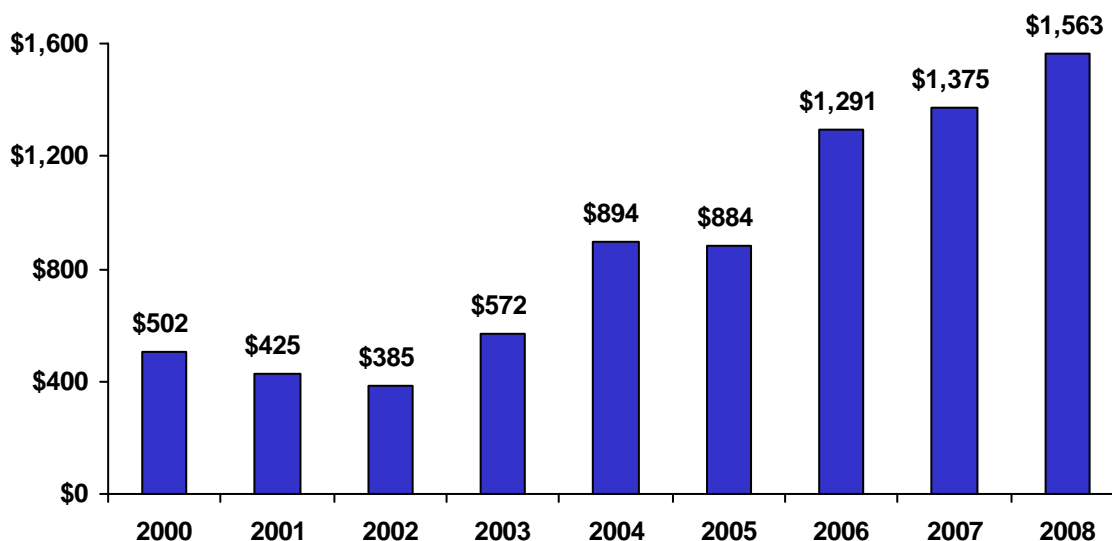

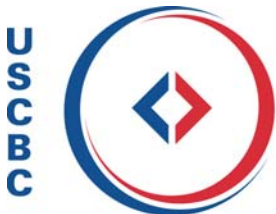

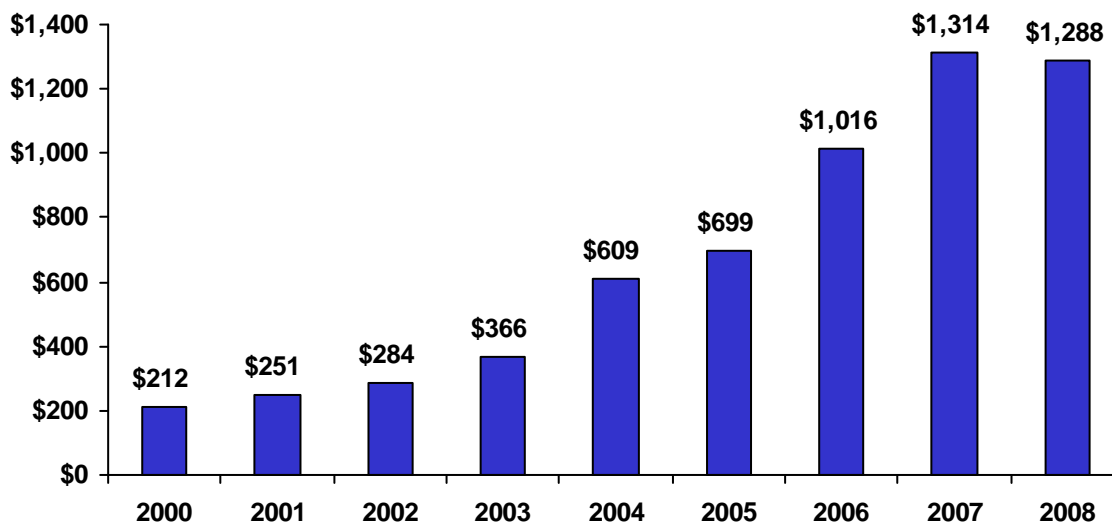

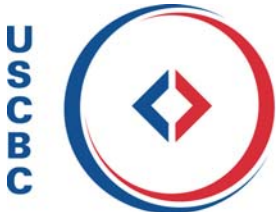

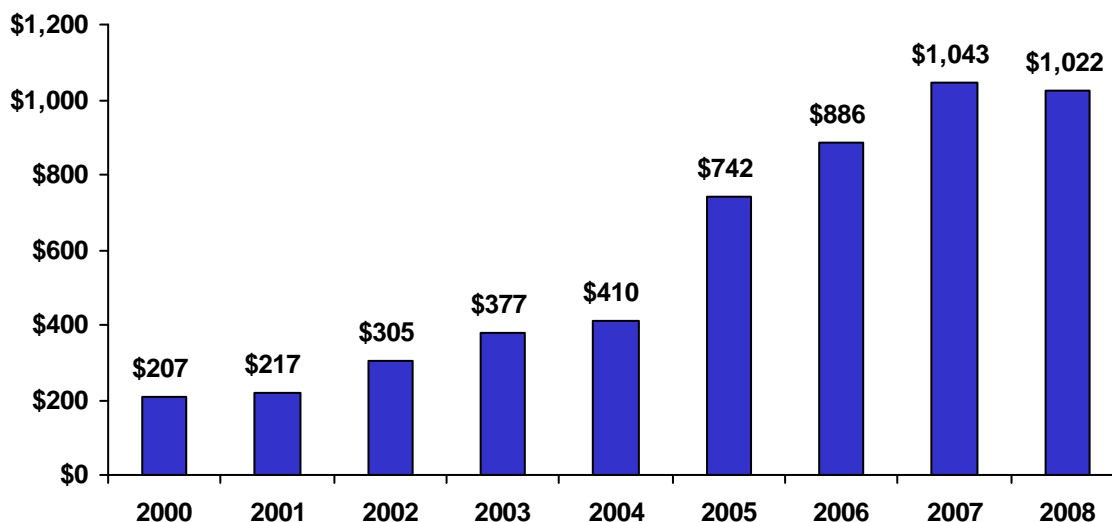

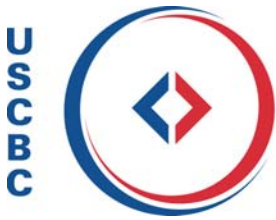

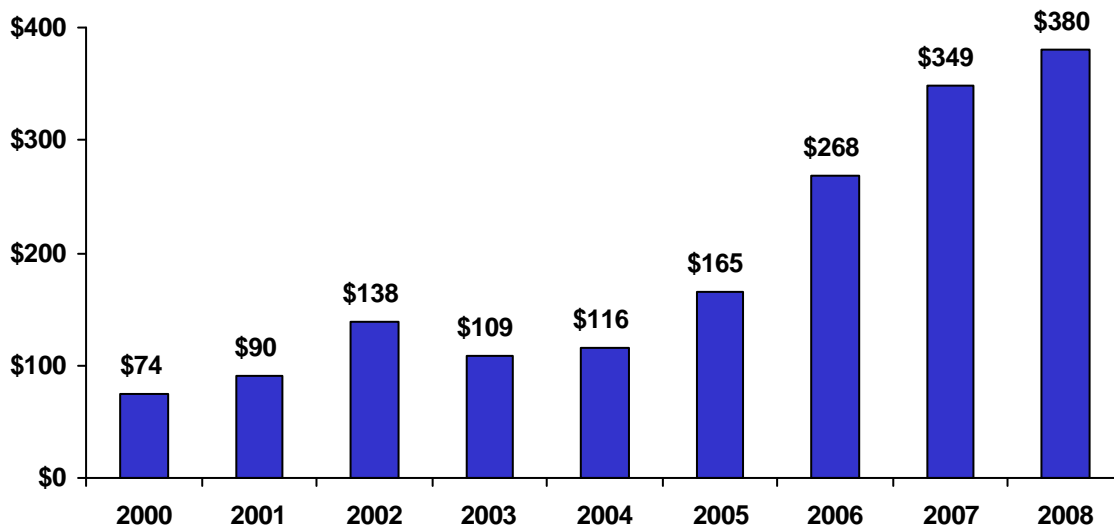

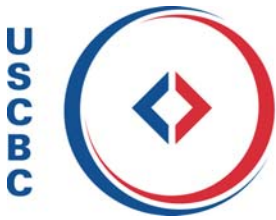

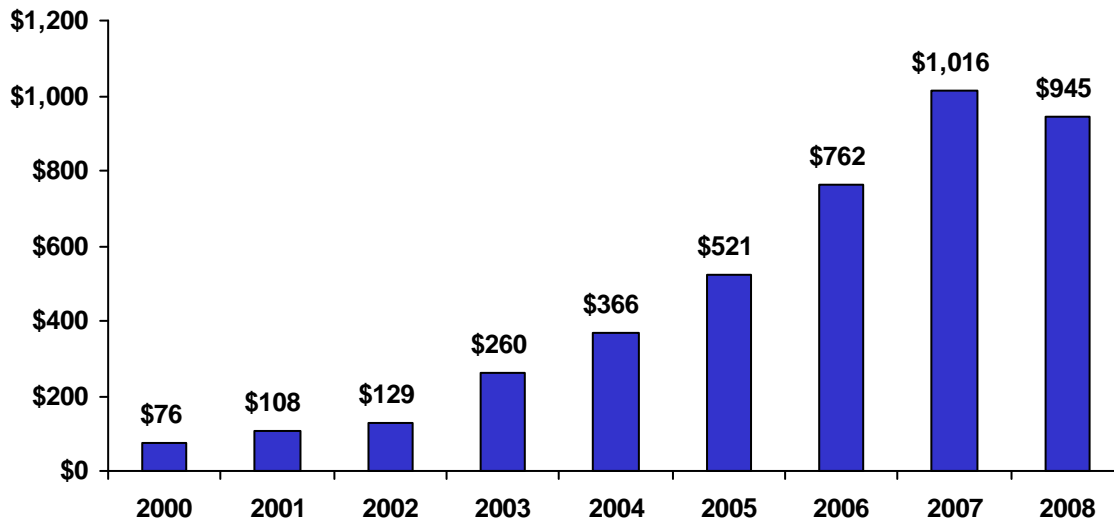

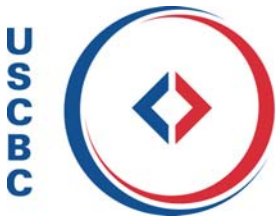

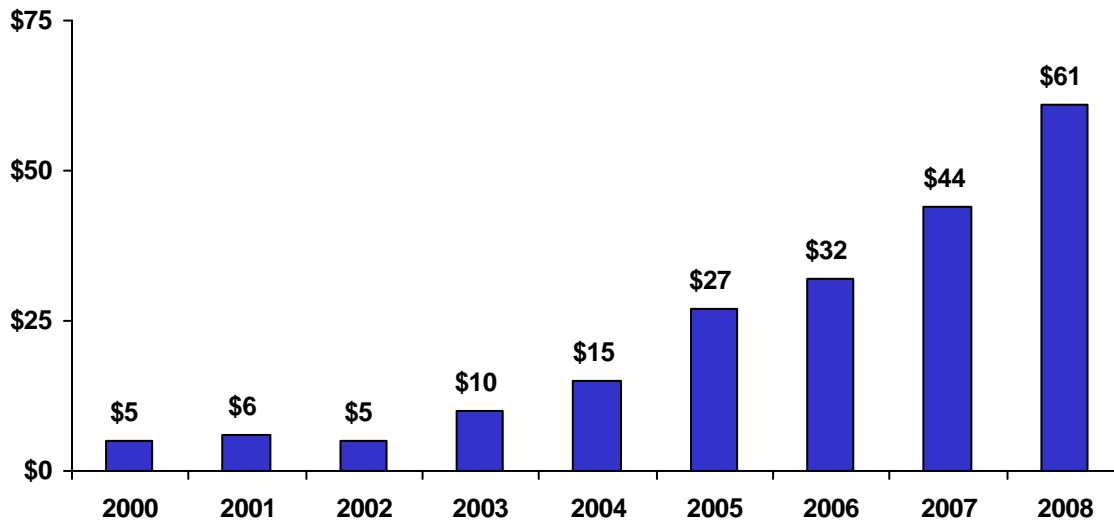

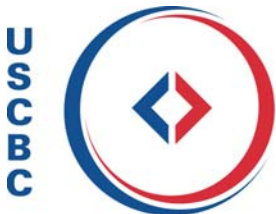

Nebraska Exports to China (\$ million)

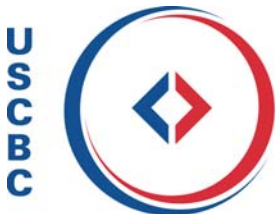

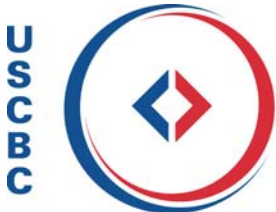

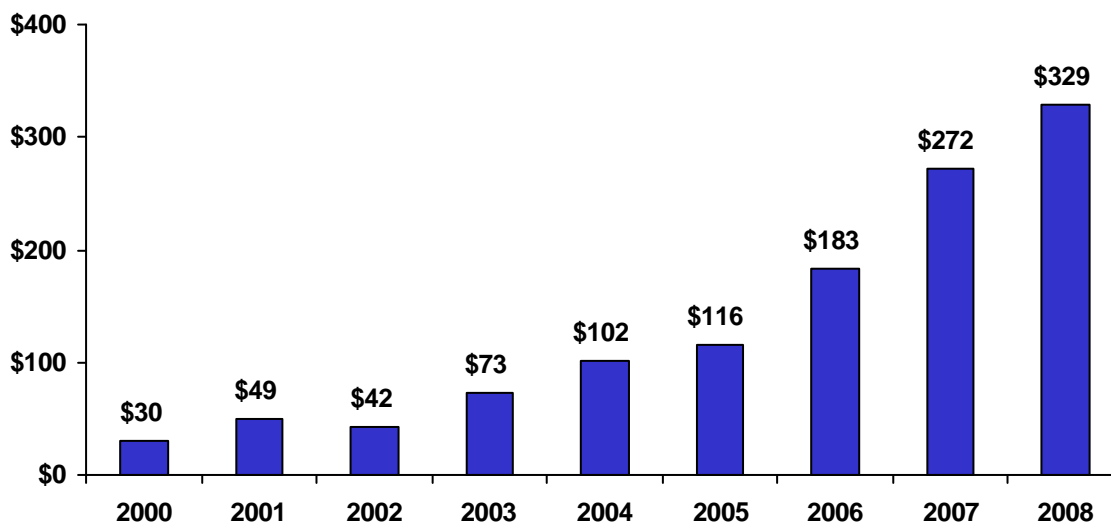

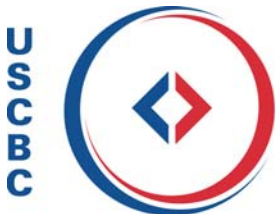

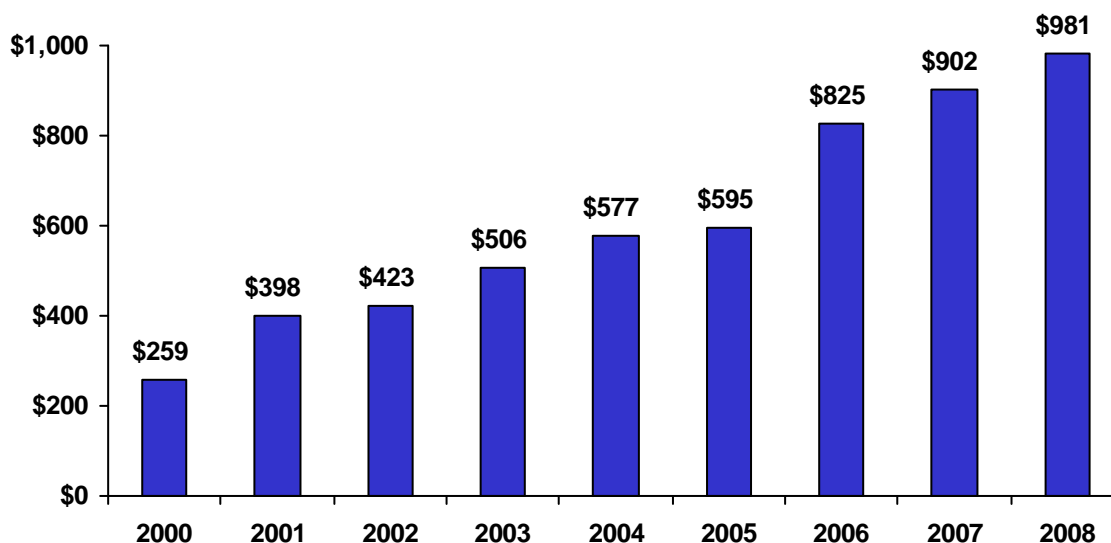

New Jersey Exports to China (\$ million)

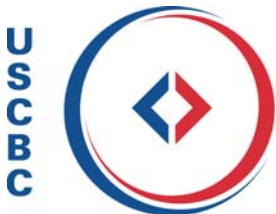

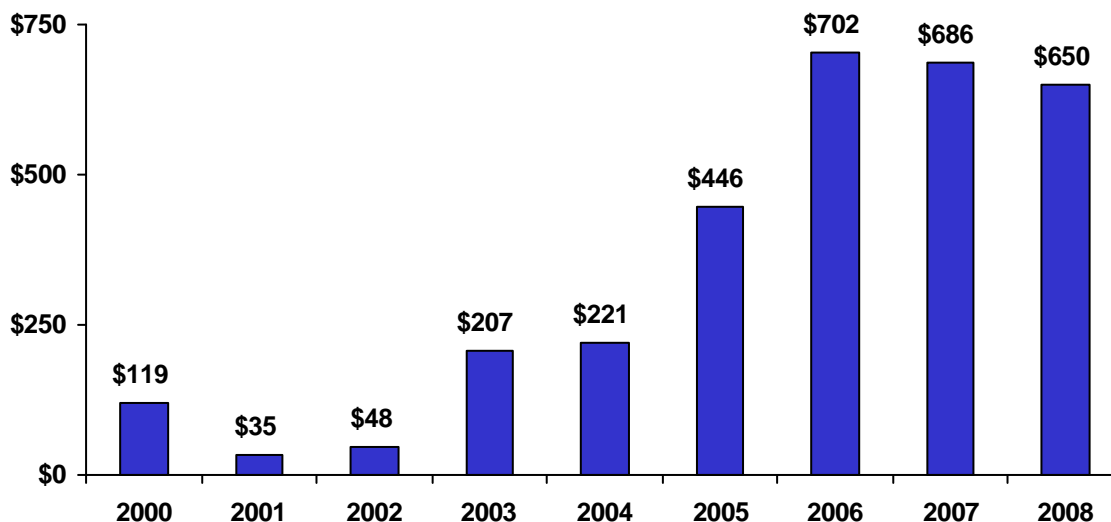

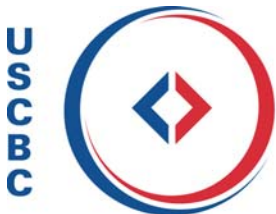

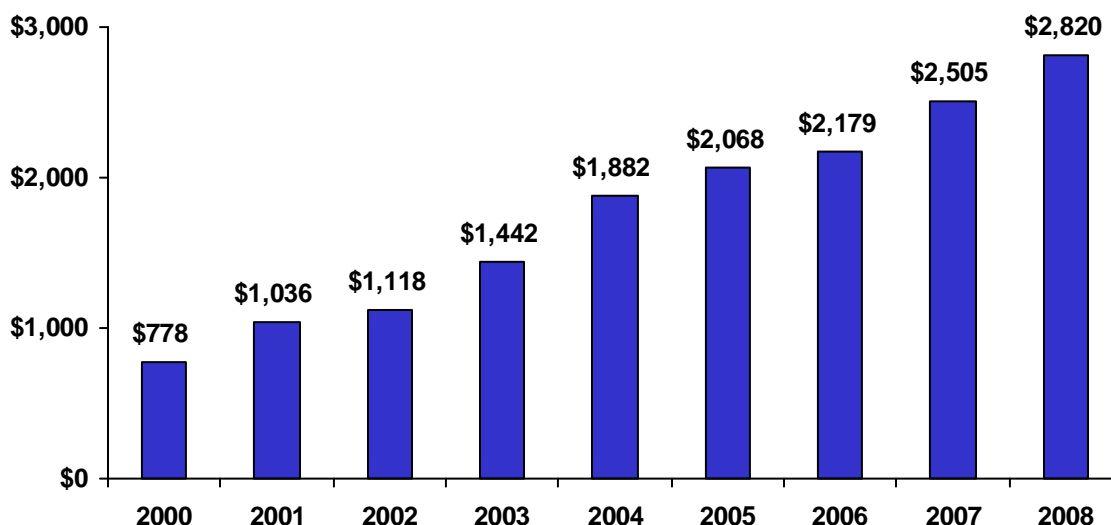

New York Exports to China (\$ million)

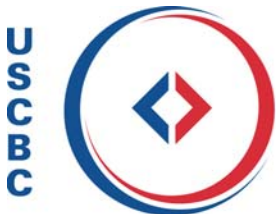

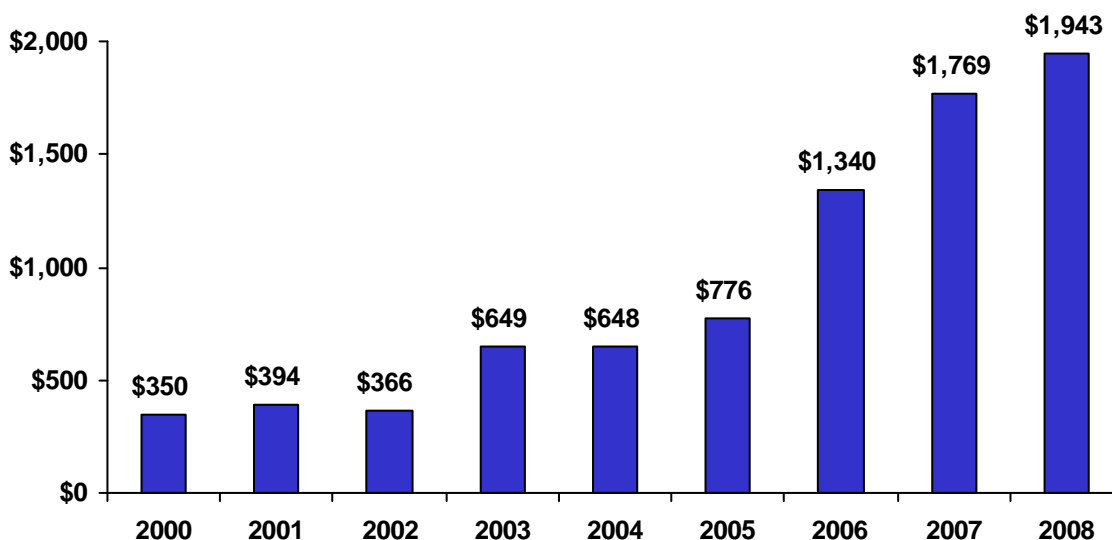

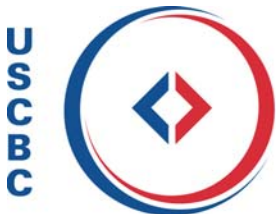

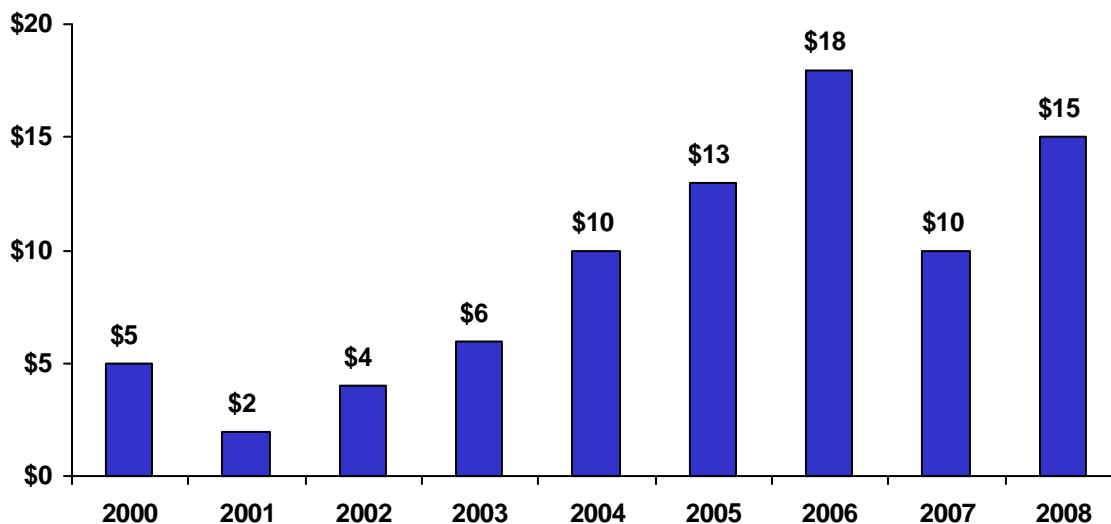

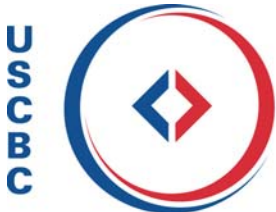

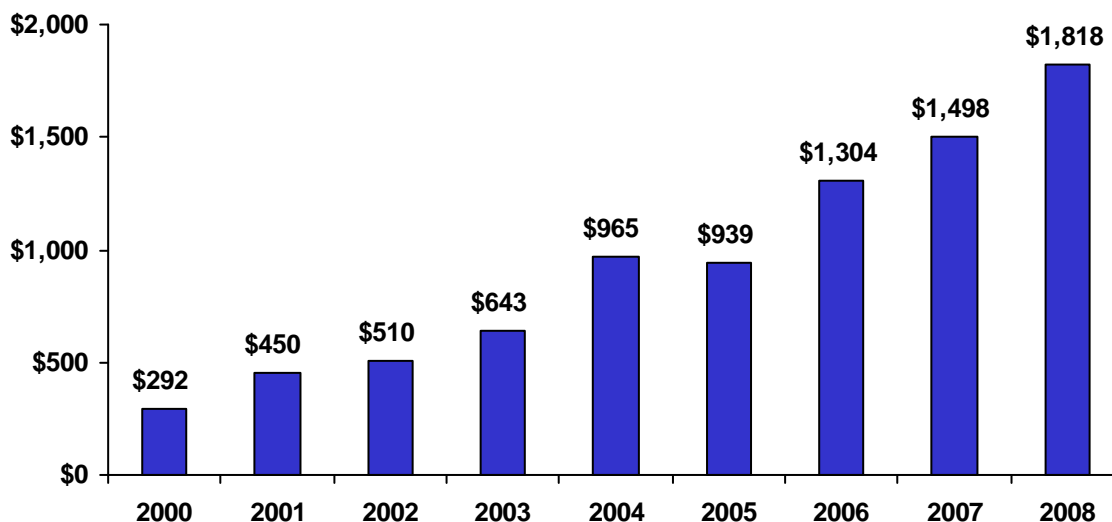

Ohio Exports to China (\$ million)

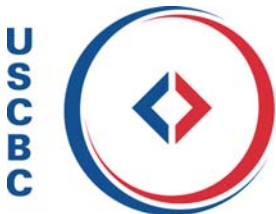

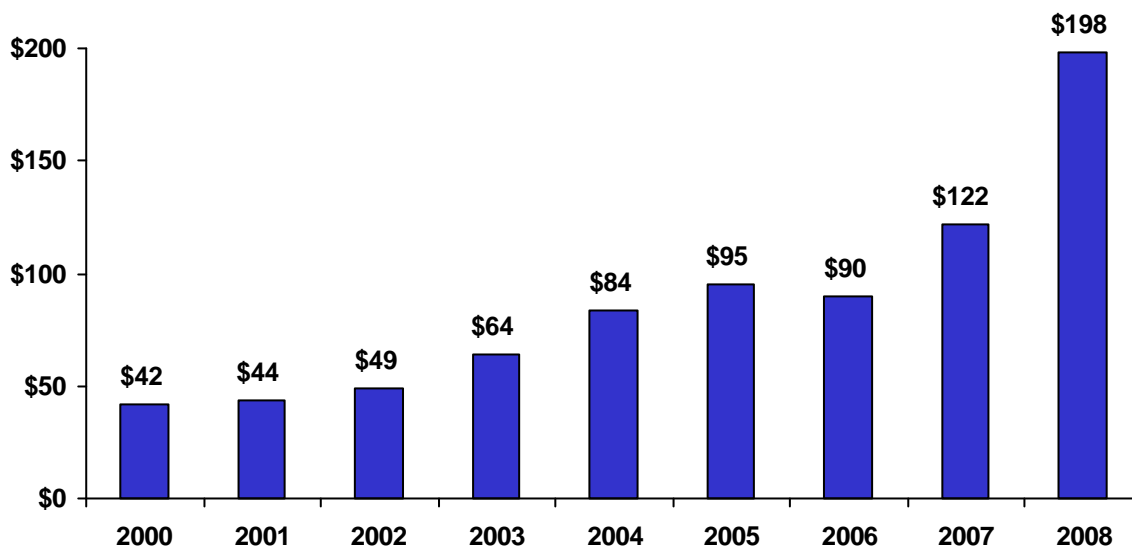

Oklahoma Exports to China (\$ million)

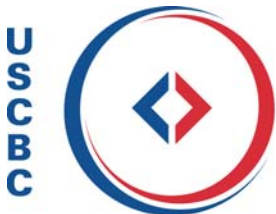

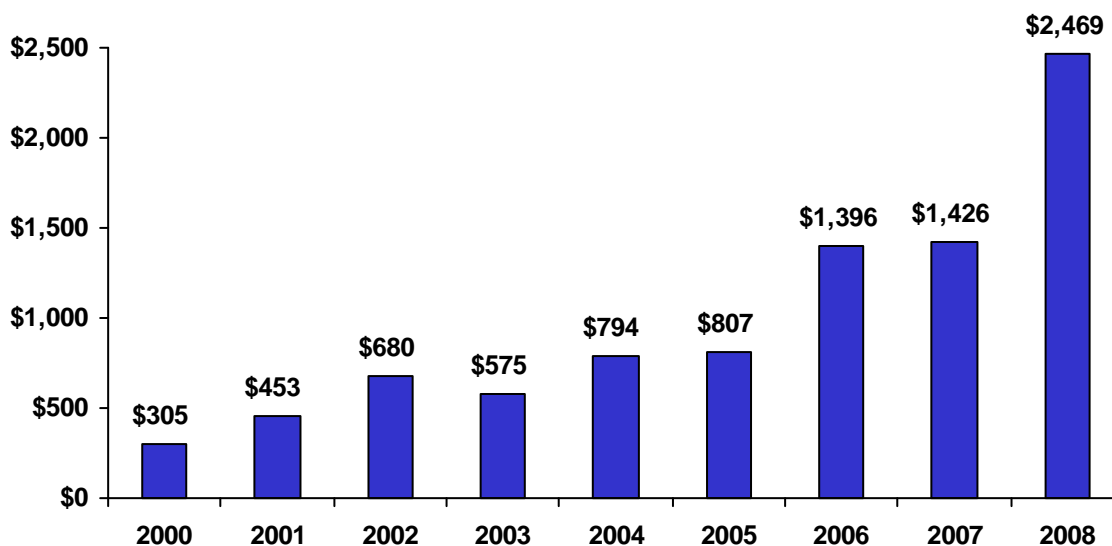

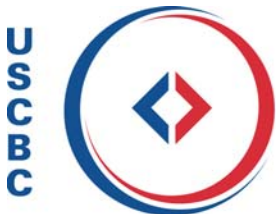

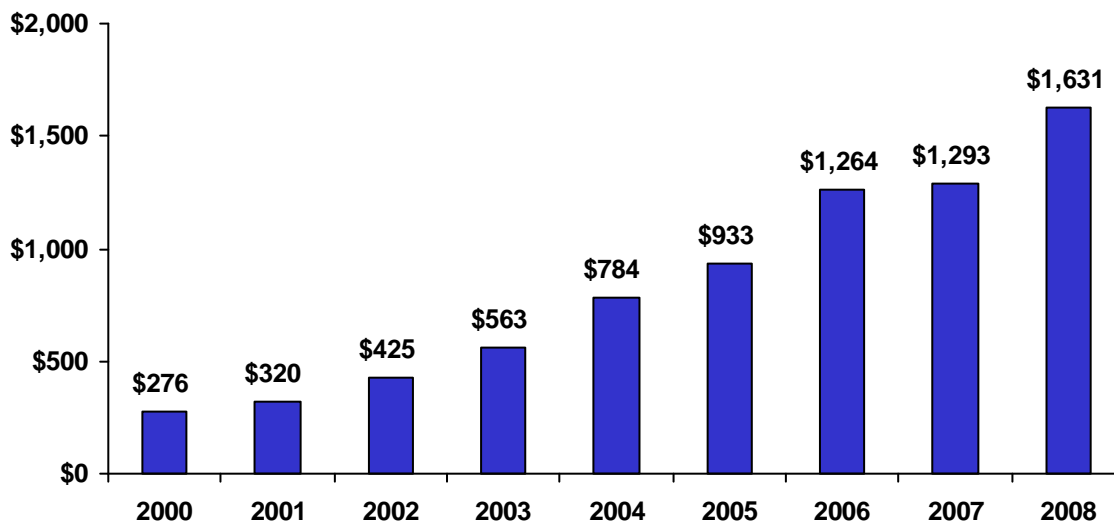

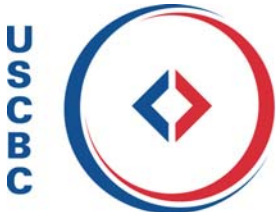

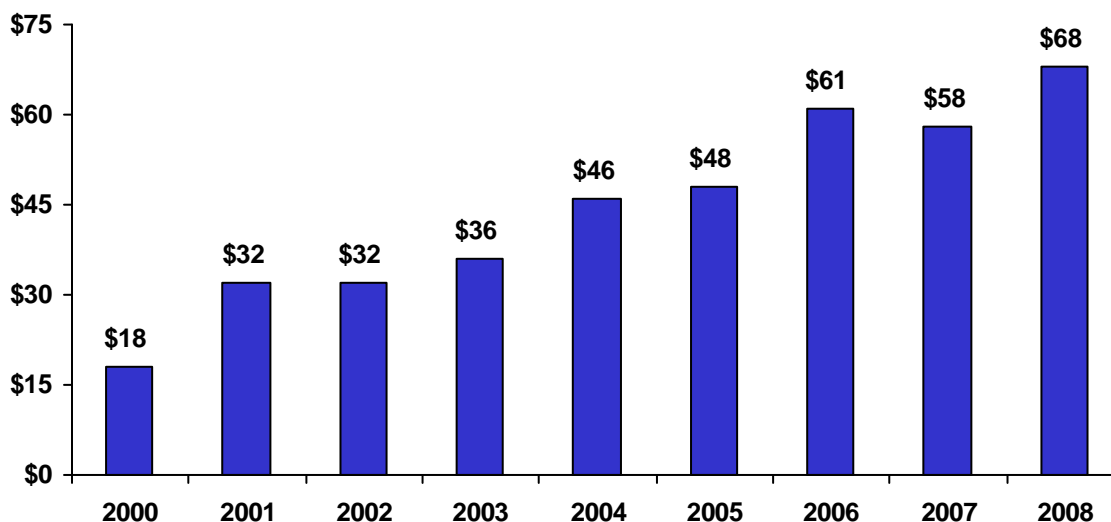

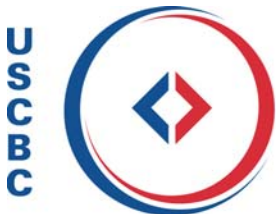

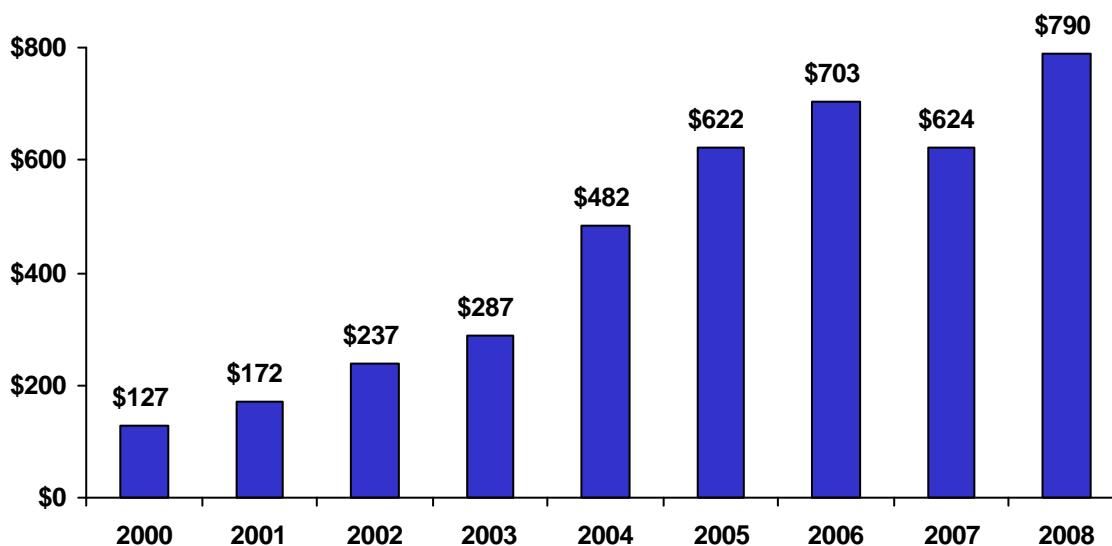

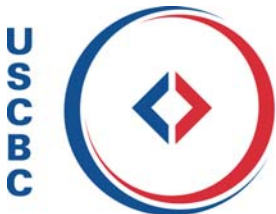

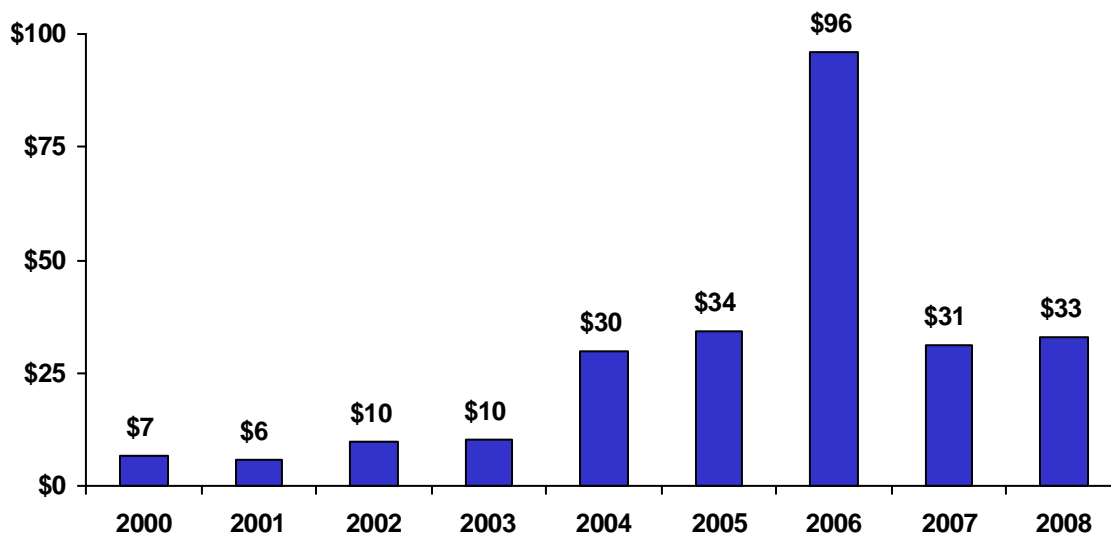

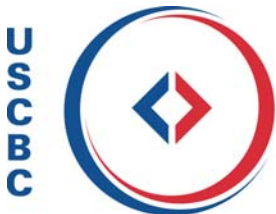

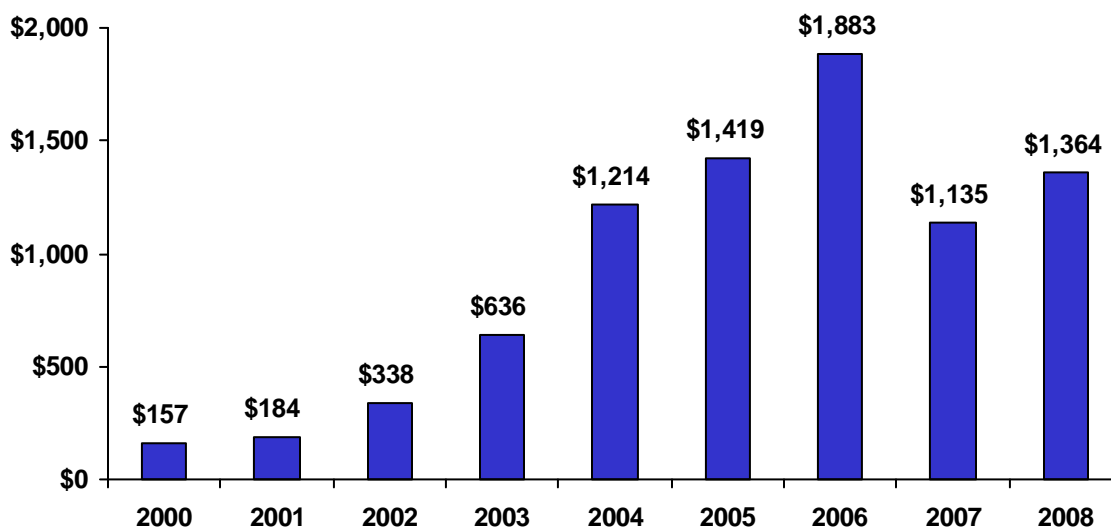

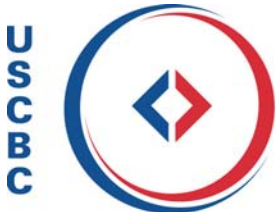

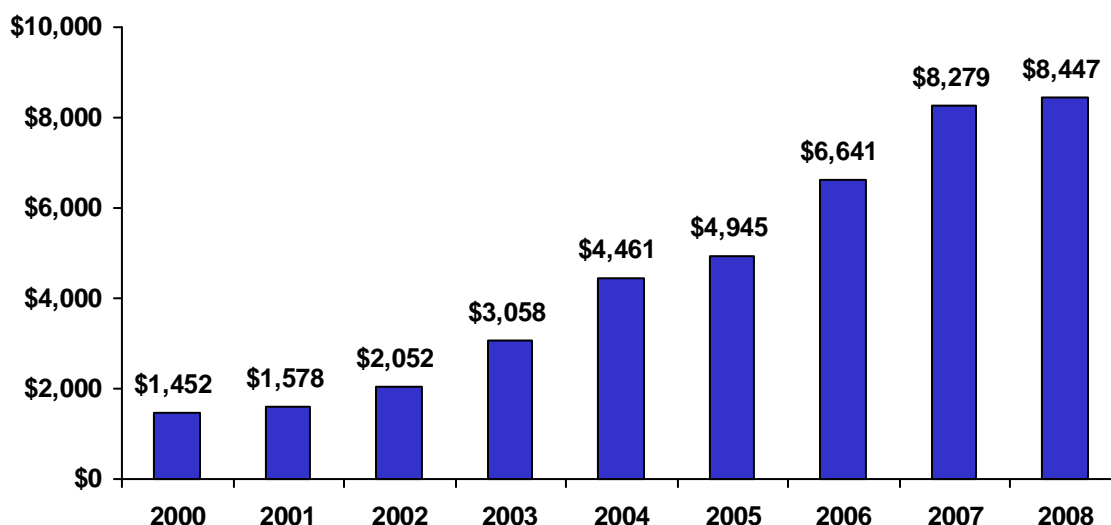

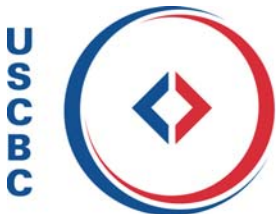

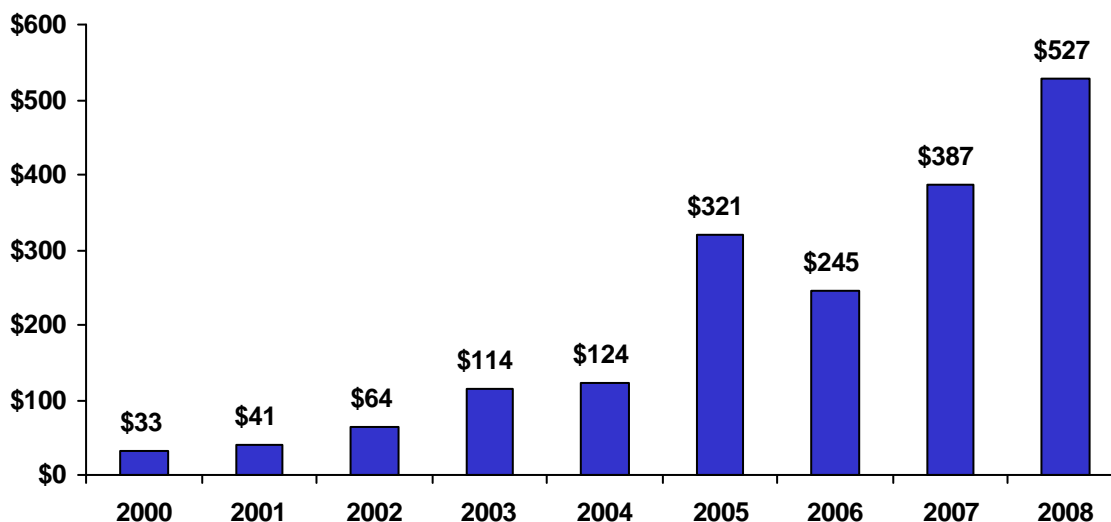

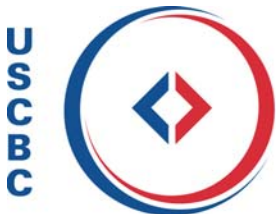

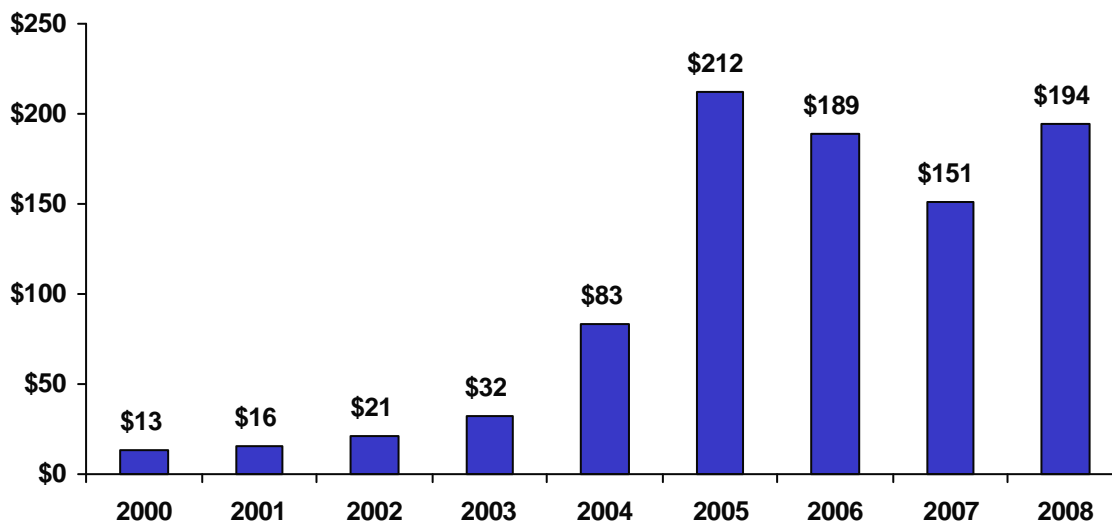

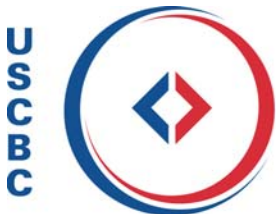

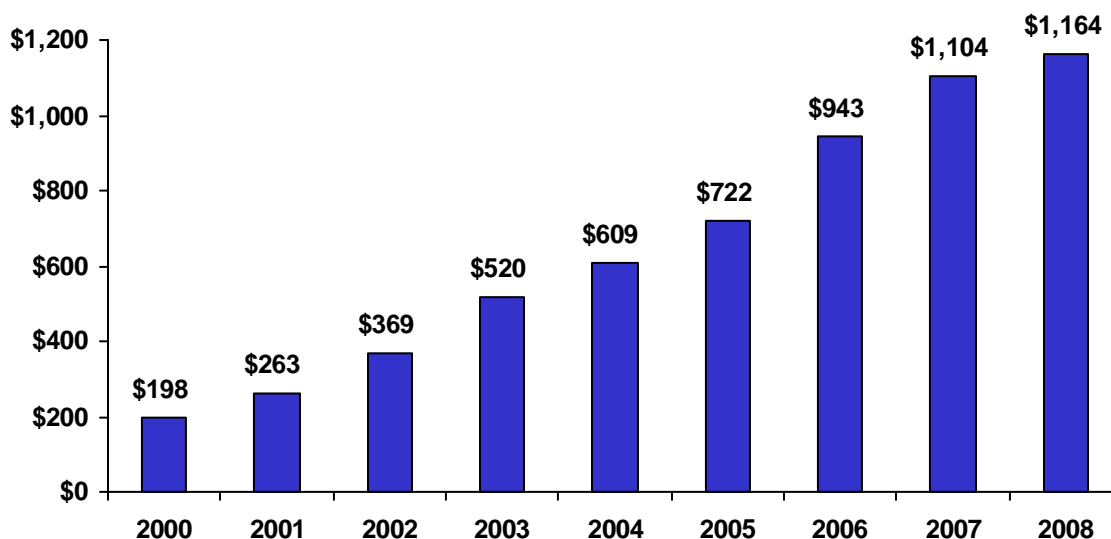

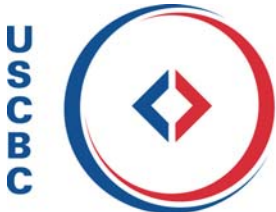

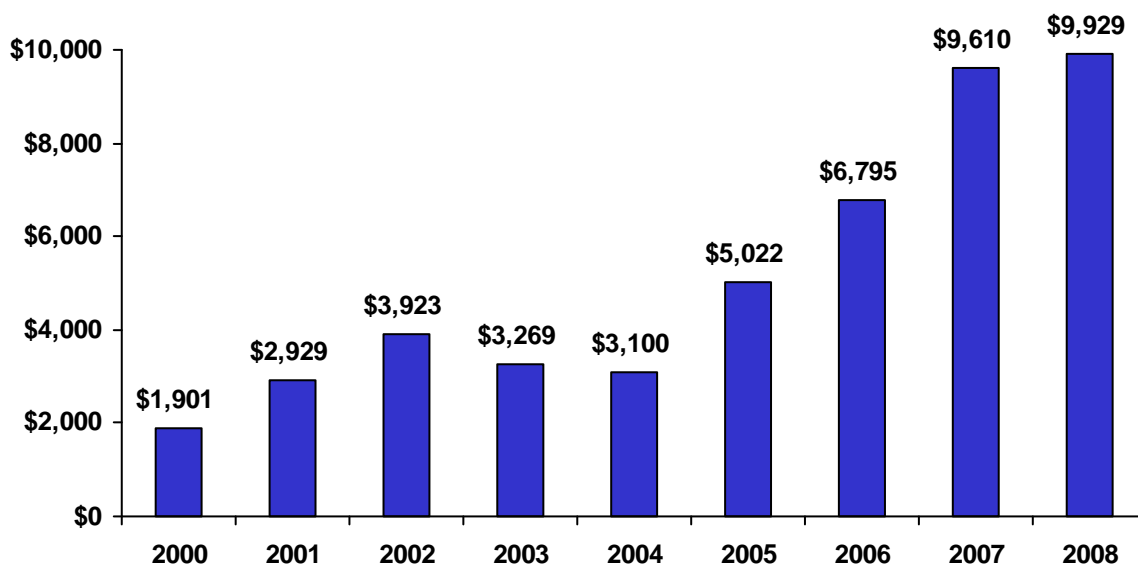

Washington Exports to China (\$ million)

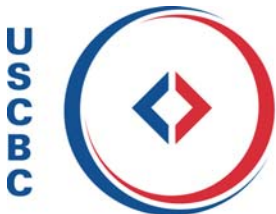

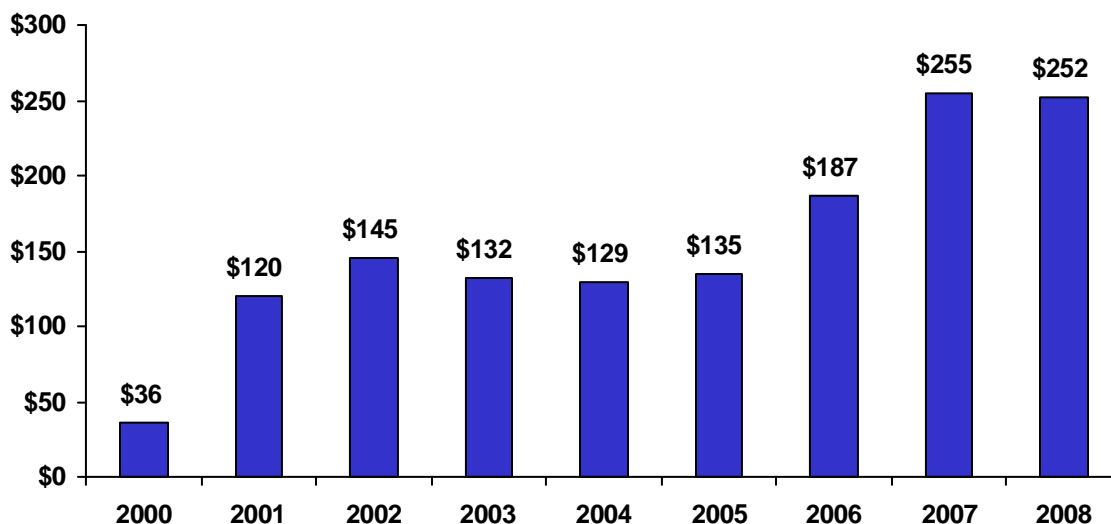

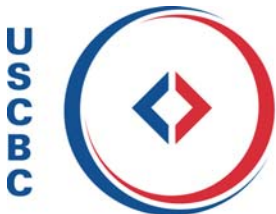

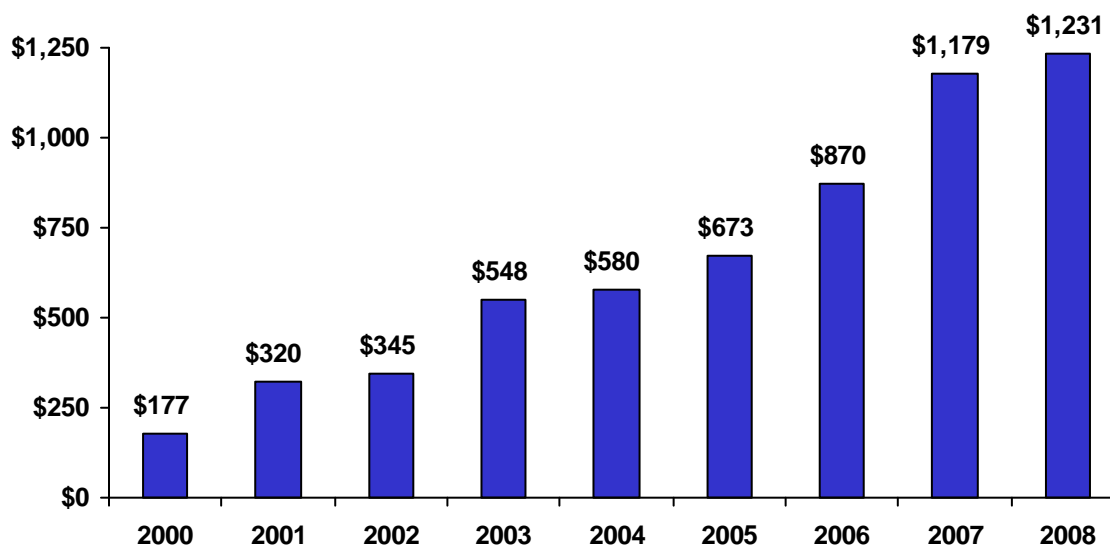

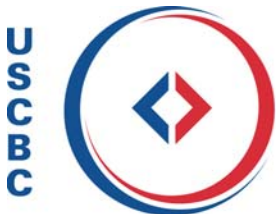

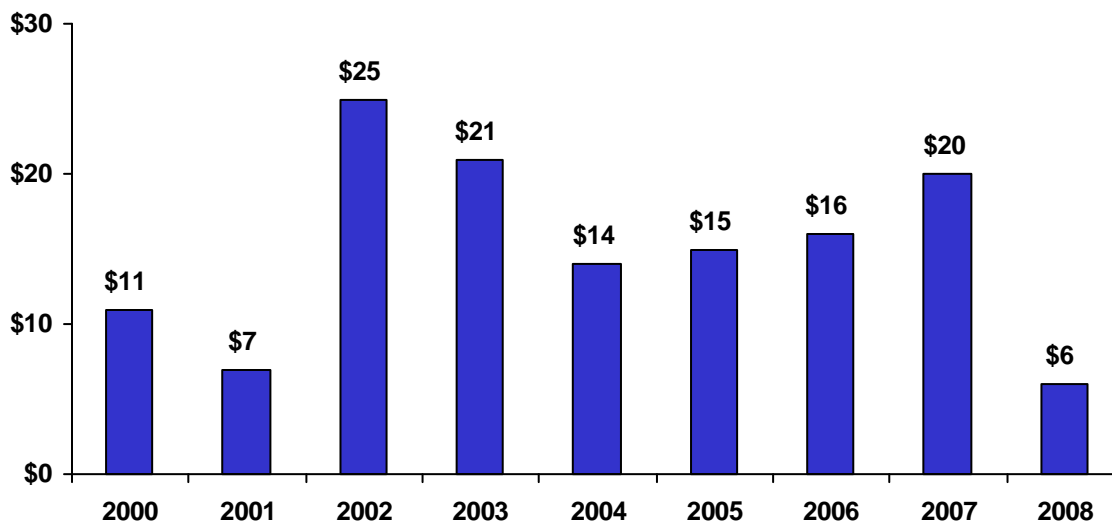
