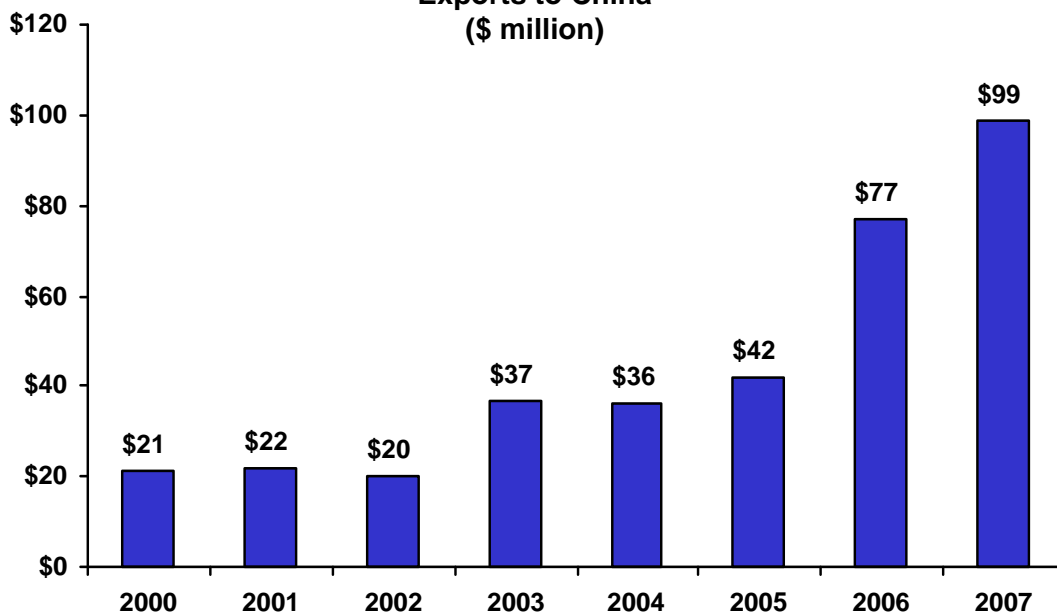

1. Computers & Electronics	\$337 million
2. Chemicals	\$261 million
3. Waste & Scrap	\$220 million
4. Machinery (except Electrical)	\$204 million
5. Paper Products	\$133 million

**NC-7: Top Exports to China, 2007\***

1. Other Manufacturing	\$71 million
2. Crop Production	\$12 million
3. Nonmetallic Mineral Products	\$4 million
4. Processed Foods	\$3 million
5. Wood Products	\$3 million

\* The data for NC-7 reflect the combined exports of Bladen, Brunswick, Columbus, Cumberland, Duplin, New Hanover, Pender, Robeson, Sampson, and Scotland counties. The figures may understate the NC-7 district's total exports to China because county-specific information for some products (e.g., mining, forestry, fishing, and waste and scrap) is not available.
