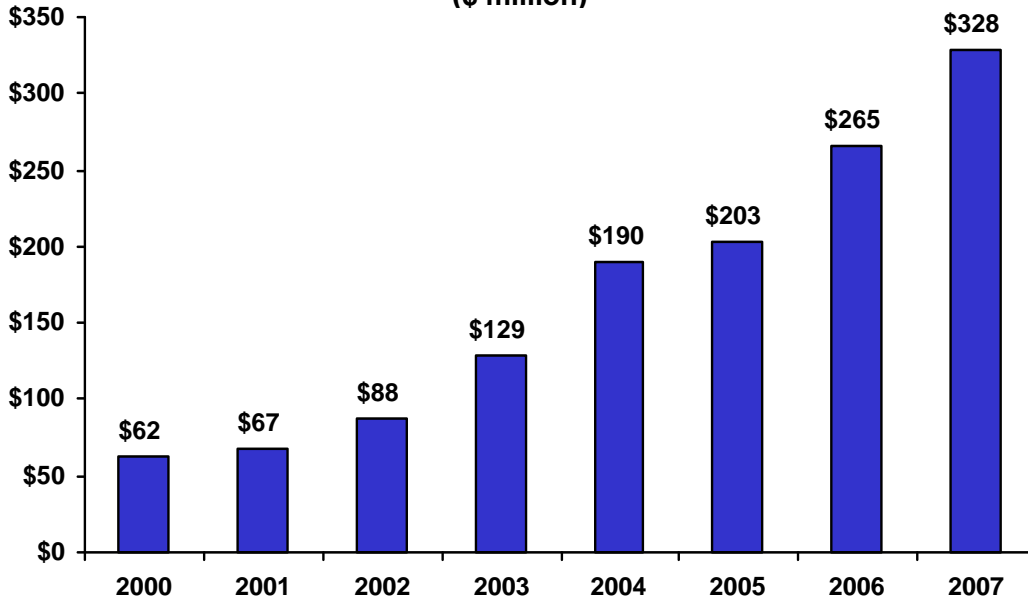




Texas' 4th Congressional District: Exports to China (\$ million)

Texas' Top Exports to China, 2007

1. Chemicals	\$2.6 billion
2. Computers & Electronics	\$1.7 billion
3. Machinery (except Electrical)	\$1.2 billion
4. Waste & Scrap	\$686 million
5. Crop Production	\$619 million

TX-4: Top Exports to China, 2007*

1. Other Manufacturing	\$186 million
2. Computers & Electronics	\$94 million
3. Crop Production	\$20 million
4. Fabricated Metal Products	\$9 million
5. Primary Metal Manufacturing	\$9 million

* The data for TX-4 reflect the combined exports of Bowie, Camp, Cass, Collin, Delta, Fannin, Franklin, Grayson, Hopkins, Hunt, Lamar, Morris, Rain, Red River, Rockwall, and Titus counties. The figures may understate the TX-4 district's total exports to China because county-specific information for some products (e.g., mining, forestry, fishing, and waste and scrap) is not available.
