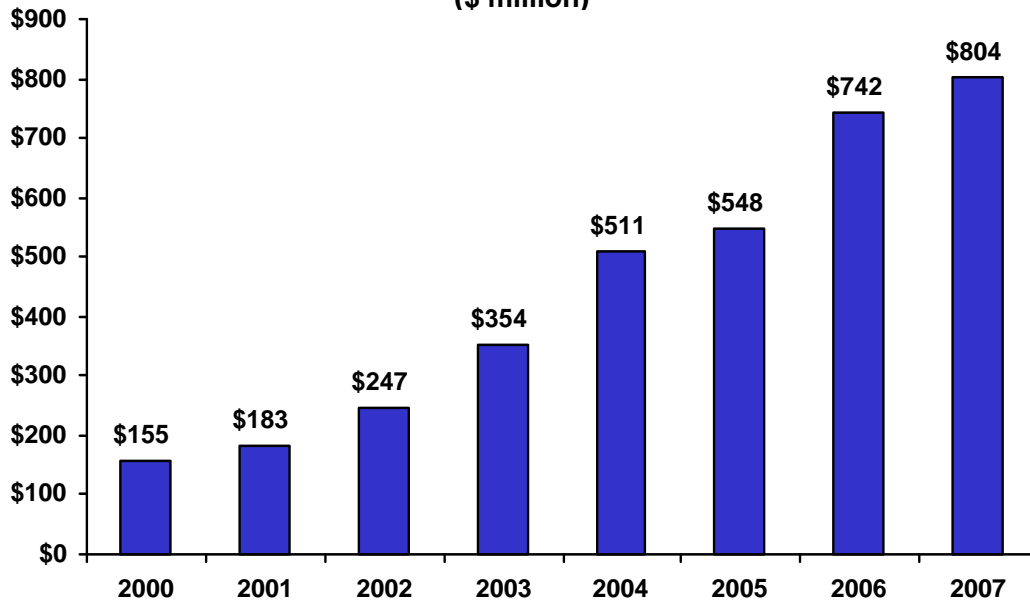




**Texas' 5th Congressional District: Exports to China

**Texas' Top Exports to China, 2007**

1. Chemicals	\$2.6 billion
2. Computers & Electronics	\$1.7 billion
3. Machinery (except Electrical)	\$1.2 billion
4. Waste & Scrap	\$686 million
5. Crop Production	\$619 million

**TX-5: Top Exports to China, 2007\***

1. Computers & Electronics	\$382 million
2. Chemicals	\$140 million
3. Machinery (except Electrical)	\$127 million
4. Processed Foods	\$30 million
5. Crop Production	\$28 million

\* The data for TX-5 reflect the combined exports of Anderson, Cherokee, Dallas, Henderson, Kaufman, Van Zandt, and Wood counties. The figures may understate the TX-5 district's total exports to China because county-specific information for some products (e.g., mining, forestry, fishing, and waste and scrap) is not available.
