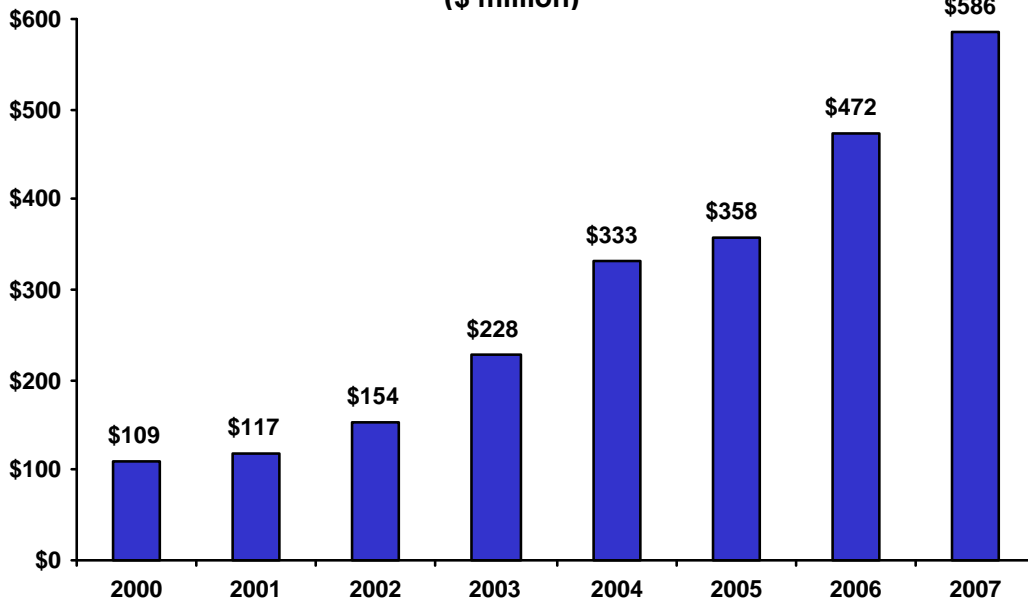




Texas' 14th Congressional District: Exports to China (\$ million)

Texas' Top Exports to China, 2007

1. Chemicals	\$2.6 billion
2. Computers & Electronics	\$1.7 billion
3. Machinery (except Electrical)	\$1.2 billion
4. Waste & Scrap	\$686 million
5. Crop Production	\$619 million

TX-14: Top Exports to China, 2007\*

1. Chemicals	\$339 million
2. Other Manufacturing	\$187 million
3. Crop Production	\$51 million
4. Fabricated Metal Products	\$8 million
5. Plastics & Rubber Products	\$939,000

\* The data for TX-14 reflect the combined exports of Aransas, Brazoria, Calhoun, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Jackson, Matagorda, Victoria, and Wharton counties. The figures may understate the TX-14 district's total exports to China because county-specific information for some products (e.g., mining, forestry, fishing, and waste and scrap) is not available.
