交通运输部

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MOT is the principal organization overseeing development strategies, regulations, and standards for road, water, rail, and air transportation, and construction and communications. Within its scope, MOT is charged with regulating the car rental industry, the transportation of vehicles for import and export, and shipping on international waterways and border rivers. It also supervises road and waterway construction quality and work safety, and is responsible for guiding environmental protection and energy conservation in the road and waterway sectors. MOT also monitors the operation of the national transportation network, collects transportation-related statistics, coordinates emergency response work, engages in international cooperation related to roads and waterways, and regulates the fishing industry.

<p>Financial Affairs (财务审计司) Xu Chunfeng 许春风 Drafts financial regulations; manages ministry finances and assets; collects, categorizes, analyzes, and releases financial information on the transportation industry; manages financing, credit, foreign exchange, government procurement, and foreign capital for transportation-related construction; conducts internal auditing.</p>	<p>Personnel and Labor (人事教育司) Chen Ruisheng 陈瑞生 Drafts policies and regulations related to CCP and cadre personnel affairs, labor wages, and organizational structure; guides ministry technical and skills training of personnel; and seeks foreign expertise.</p>	<p>Roads (公路局) Li Yanwu 李彦武 Drafts industrial policies, regulations, and technical standards for road construction; supervises road construction projects; manages related markets such as road and car repairs and driver training; and manages transport across borders.</p>
<p>Waterway Transport (水运局) Gao Pengfei 高鹏飞 Manages construction of waterway infrastructure and related projects; drafts industrial policy and technical standards; establishes maintenance, water transportation service, and emergency transportation management.</p>	<p>Scientific Education (科技司) Pang Song 庞松 Drafts, implements, and supervises policies and regulations on scientific education; plans and organizes transportation-related science education; guides transport industry informatization work; organizes national scientific achievement and award declarations; promotes international technology exchange and study abroad based on transportation technology.</p>	<p>Maritime Search and Rescue Center (中国海上搜救中心) Organizes, mediates, and directs maritime search and rescue efforts; responds to sea pollution emergencies and drafts related maritime regulations; attends international conventions; participates in international rescue cooperation; and manages daily affairs of the department's work with the State Council.</p>
<p>Public Security Bureau (公安局) Wu Jianping 吴建平 Directs port and security work, including aviation security in conjunction with the Ministry of Public Security.</p>	<p>International Cooperation (国际合作司) Zhang Xiaojie 张晓杰 Manages foreign transportation affairs and transportation industry cooperation with foreign governments.</p>	<p>Safety and Quality Assurance (安全与质量监督司) Cheng Ping 成平 Responsible for supervising the safety and quality of public roads and waterways.</p>
