NDRC is China's macroeconomic planning body responsible for formulating and implementing strategies for national economic and social development and coordinating economic restructuring. NDRC directs industry policies, fixed-asset investment, and regional economic development. It is also one of the lead agencies in charge of formulating market access policies for foreign investment, managing pilot projects, and setting import-export targets.

 Oversees the Fixed Assets Investment Department, Rural Economics Department, Resource Conservation and Environmental Protection Department, Department of Temporary Overseas Personnel, NDRC Party Committee, Bureau of Retired Officials, and Department of Trade. Responsible for liaising with the National Investment Project Evaluation Center, National Energy Conservation Center, China National Association of Engineering Consultants, and China Association of Construction Enterprise Management. Temporarily responsible for liaising with the training center, and the State Food and Material Reserve Bureau.

**Department Responsibilities**

**General Office (办公厅)**

Overseas day-to-day operations of the Commission, including processing documents, organizing meetings, confidential information communication, archives, etc. Responsible for information acquisition, confidentiality management, handling of complaint letters and visits, and government information disclosure, as well as the Commission's budget and finance, assets management, and internal auditing.

**Department of Policy Studies (政策研究室)**

**Yan Pengcheng 严鹏程**

Responsible for drafting important documents, organizing studies on key issues concerning economic and social development, reform and opening-up, and international economy. In charge of news release and providing information guidance.

**Department of Development Planning (发展规划司)**

**Chen Yajun 陈亚军**

Responsible for recommending strategies for national economic and social development and productivity allocation. Recommends objectives and policies for medium and long-term national economic and social development, and economic balancing and structural readjustment. Proposes development strategies and key policy measures for urbanization. Coordinates, implements, monitors, and evaluates major economic, social and regional development plans.

**Department of National Economy (国民经济综合司)**

**Cong Liang 丛亮**

Responsible for monitoring and analyzing the domestic macro-economic situation and international economic dynamics, conducting forecasting, studying economic aggregate balance and proposing policy recommendations. Identifies macro-economic regulation objectives and recommends economic tools and policies. Conducts micro-economic policy evaluation, drafts annual plans for national economic and social development, puts forward annual aggregate targets and balancing policies for key commodities, recommends policy for national strategic material reserves, formulates and coordinates plan for national strategic material reserves, and studies and formulates policy recommendations concerning national economic security and general industry security strategy.

**Bureau of Economic Operations Adjustment (经济运行调节局)**

**Zhao Chenxin 赵辰昕**

Responsible for monitoring and analyzing national economic performance and putting forward corresponding policy recommendations. Coordinates resolution of major economic problems, organizes the dispatching of coal, electricity, oil, gas and other important materials and coordinating their transportation. Makes recommendations on managing key emergency materials reserves and drawing on national material reserves.

**Department of Economic System Reform (经济体制综合改革司)**

**Xu Shanchang 徐善长**

Responsible for guiding, promoting and coordinating economic system reform. Conducts studies on important issues concerning economic system reform and opening up, drafts comprehensive economic reform plans, participates in the drafting and harmonization of economic reform plans and implementation led by other departments (bureaus) within NDRC or other agencies, guides the progress of pilot projects and demonstrative zones for economic system reform, and coordinates the solution to major problems during the process of economic system reform.



### Department Responsibilities

#### Department of Fixed-Asset Investment (固定资产投资司)

**Ou Hong 欧鸿**

Responsible for monitoring and analyzing all fixed asset investment activities and proposing regulatory objectives, policies, and measures concerning overall scale and structure of fixed asset investments. Drafts laws and regulations for fixed asset investment management, recommends reforms to deepen investment structure and revise the catalogue of fixed asset investment projects, examines and approves major construction projects according to the mandate from the State Council, and guides the growth of engineering consulting service industry.

#### Department of Foreign Capital and Overseas Investment (利用外资和境外投资司)

**Gu Dawei 顾大伟**

Responsible for analyzing the dynamics of international capital, foreign capital utilization and overseas investment. Recommends objectives and policies regarding strategies and plans for aggregate balance and structural optimization of foreign capital utilization and overseas investment. Coordinates relevant key policies, monitors, controls and optimizes the total size and mix of foreign liabilities, jointly drafts plans with relevant agencies for loans from international financial organizations and foreign governments, and recommends candidate projects. With mandate from the State Council, drafts the Catalogue for the Guidance of Foreign Investment Industries in cooperation with relevant agencies, and examines and approves key foreign-invested projects.

#### Department of Regional Economy (地区经济司)

**Guo Lanfeng 郭兰峰**

Responsible for drafting regional economic development plans and recommending major regional economic development policies. Coordinates policies for land improvement, land development, utilization and protection, participates in the formulation of land use policies, water conservation, ecological improvement, and environmental management and protection. Organizes and implements the development planning of main functional regions, guides regional economic cooperation, formulates economic development programs for border areas, poverty-stricken areas and ethnic autonomous areas, and maps "work for relief" programs. Coordinates and implements the strategic plans and key policies to promote the development of the central region.

#### Department of Western Region Development (西部开发司)

**Zhao Ai 赵艾**

Responsible for formulating strategies, plans and key policies to promote Western region development, and coordinating major issues. Proposes key infrastructure development projects, ecological environment conservation and layout of major projects in the Western region, and coordinates implementation.

#### Department of Northeastern Region Revitalization (东北等老工业基地振兴司)

**Tong Zhangshun 童章舜**

Responsible for formulating strategies, plans and key policies to promote the revitalization of Northeast China and other old industrial bases, and coordinating major key issues. Develops proposals for the adjustment and upgrade of old industrial bases, sustainable development of natural resource-based cities, layout of major projects, and coordinates implementation.

#### Department of Rural Economy (农村经济司)

**Wu Xiao 吴晓**

Responsible for analyzing the development of agriculture and rural economy. Develops policy recommendations for rural economic development strategies and the reform of the rural economic system, coordinates major issues concerning agriculture and rural economic and social development, coordinates and balances development plans and policies for agriculture, forestry, water conservation and meteorology, and develops and implements proposals for the layout of major projects.



### Department Responsibilities

#### Department of Basic Industries (基础产业司)

**Luo Guosan 罗国三**

Responsible for coordinating and harmonizing energy and transportation development plans with national economic and social development plans and programs. Analyzes performance of the energy and transportation industries, coordinates relevant key issues, and makes relevant policy recommendations.

#### Department of Industry (产业协调司)

**Nian Yong 年勇**

Responsible for analyzing major issues concerning the development of industry and service industry. Drafts comprehensive industrial policies, and studies and proposes comprehensive policy recommendations. Coordinates and harmonizes the industry and service industry development plans with national economic and social development plans and programs, and coordinates the dissemination and use of major technical equipment and construction of major industrial bases.

#### Department of High-Tech Industry (高技术产业司)

**Ren Zhiwu 任志武**

Responsible for analyzing the dynamics of the high-tech industry and technological development. Drafts strategies, plans, and policies to promote the development of high-tech industry and advancement of technologies, organizes major industrialization demonstration projects, coordinates and synchronizes informatization development plans with national economic and social development plans and programs, organizes and promotes technological innovation and the integration of industry, academia and research, and promotes the formation of new industries of the national economy.

#### Department of Resource Conservation and Environmental Protection

(资源节约和环境保护司)

**Ren Shuben 任树本**

Responsible for comprehensively analyzing important and strategic issues related to the coordinated development of the economy, society, environment and resources. Organizes formulation and implementation of plans, policies and measures concerning the conservation and comprehensive utilization of energy and resources, and the development of the circular economy. Participates in the formulation of environmental protection plans, coordinates work related to environmental protection industry and clean production, organizes and coordinates key pilot programs for energy conservation and emissions reduction, and promotes the application of new products, technologies and equipment.

#### Department of Social Development

(社会发展司)

**Ou Xiaoli 欧晓理**

Responsible for putting forward comprehensive social development strategies; organizing the formulation and coordination of social development plans and related annual plans, coordinating development policies concerning population and family planning, culture, education, healthcare, sports, broadcasting, film and TV, tourism, law and regulation, and civil affairs. Promotes development of social undertakings and coordinates solutions to key issues in the social development and social reform.

#### Department of Trade (经济贸易司)

Responsible for monitoring and analyzing both domestic and international markets, maintaining the aggregate balance and macro adjustment of important commodities, formulating plans for the total volume of import and export of important agricultural products, industrial products, and raw materials, supervises the implementation of these plans and adjustments in accordance with national economic performance. Manages the state reserve of important materials and commodities including grain, cotton, sugar, etc. Puts forward strategies and plans for the development of modern logistics, and coordinates major issues of distribution system reform.



### Department Responsibilities

<p><b>Department of Employment and Income Distribution (就业和收入分配司)</b> <b>Li Kang 李亢</b> Responsible for comprehensively analyzing employment, human resources, income distribution, and social security. Recommends strategies and policies that encourage employment, adjusts income distribution, and improves the coordinated development of social security and economy.</p>	<p><b>Department of Fiscal and Financial Affairs (财政金融司)</b> <b>Chen Hongwan 陈洪宛</b> Responsible for studying and analyzing capital balance within society. Studies fiscal and monetary policies and issues of fiscal and financial system reform, analyzes the implementation of fiscal and monetary policies and makes recommendations, puts forward development strategies and policy recommendations concerning direct financing, reviews and approves securities issuance of non-listed companies, and takes the lead in promoting the development of investment funds and venture funds, as well as development of relevant systems.</p>	<p><b>Department of Pricing (价格司)</b> <b>Yue Xiuhu 岳修虎</b> Responsible for forecasting price changes, recommending objectives, policies, and reform plans for price adjustment. Formulates price and fee-charging policies and regulations, puts forward scope, principles and measures for price management, makes recommendations on revision of government pricing catalog, sets and adjusts prices and fees administered by the central government, and organizes cost investigation concerning major agricultural products, commodities and services.</p>
<p><b>Department of International Cooperation (国际合作司)</b> <b>Su Wei 苏伟</b> Responsible for cooperation between the NDRC and international organizations, foreign government agencies and foreign institutions. The Department is also responsible for assisting other departments to promote major international cooperation projects and carrying out studies on the world economy and day-to-day foreign affairs of the Commission.</p>	<p><b>Human Resources (人事司)</b> Responsible for managing personnel affairs, organization planning and team building for the NDRC and its affiliated institutions.</p>	<p><b>Department of Law and Regulation (法规司)</b> <b>Yang Jie 杨洁</b> Responsible for drafting laws, regulations and rules. Audits relevant regulatory documents, handles administrative reconsideration responding to administrative lawsuits, and guides and coordinates tendering according to relevant rules.</p>
<p><b>Discipline Inspection (中纪委、监察部驻委纪检组、监察局)</b> <b>Zhang Wei 张巍</b> Reviews NDRC and CCP implementation of policy decisions and ensures that operations conform to laws, regulations, and State Council decisions, investigates NDRC leadership and staff accused of violating these policies, and assists with anti-corruption work.</p>	<p><b>NDRC Party Committee (直属机关党委)</b> <b>Zhang Yong 张勇 (Secretary)</b> <b>Wen Bugao 文步高 (Deputy Secretary)</b> Responsible for work related to Party affairs in the NDRC and its affiliated State Bureaus and institutions.</p>	<p><b>Bureau of Retired Officials (离退休干部局)</b> <b>Hu Jishen 胡继申</b> Responsible for managing NDRC's retired officials and guiding the relevant work of NDRC's affiliated institutions.</p>

Oversees grain circulation, provides industry guidance, and manages central grain and material reserves.
