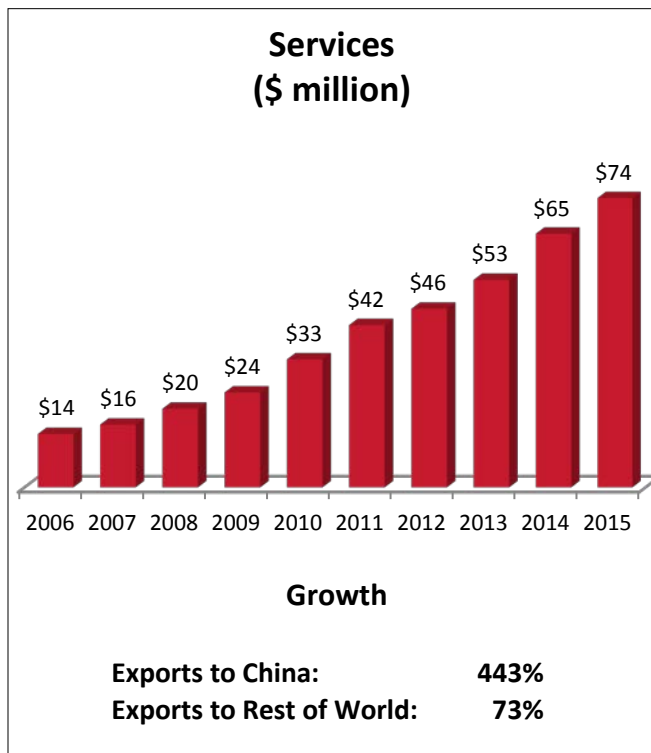
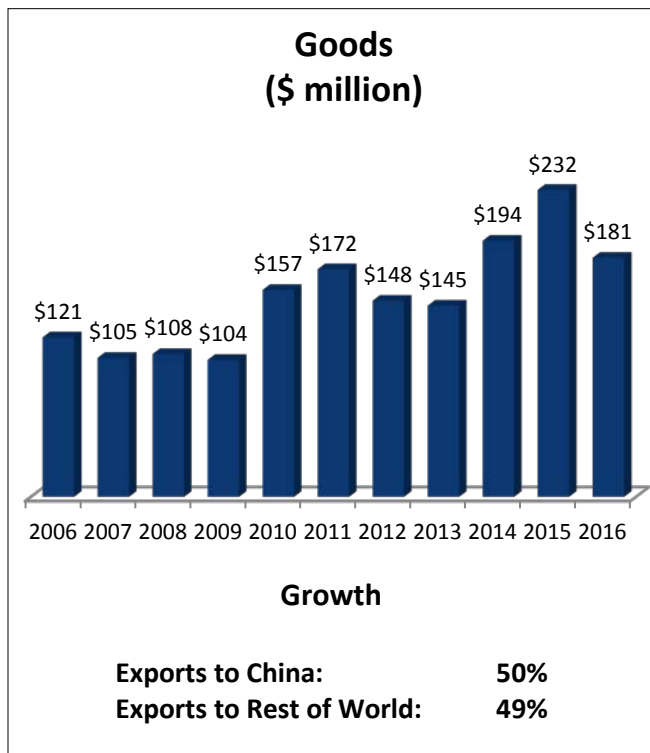




Texas' 19th Congressional District: Exports to China
