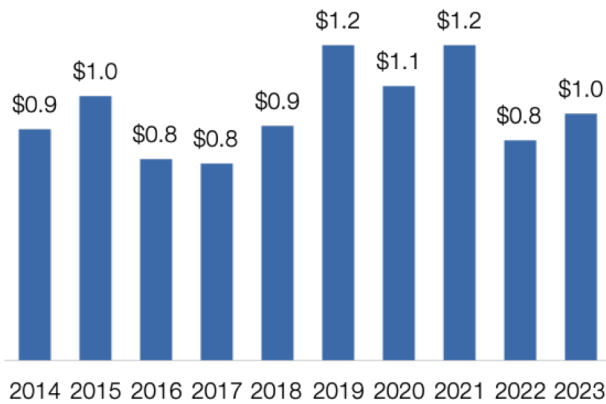


Connecticut's Exports to China

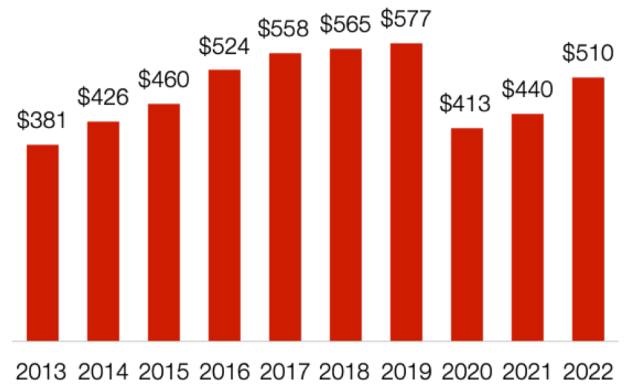
Connecticut's goods and services exports to China supported **7,590** American jobs in 2022.

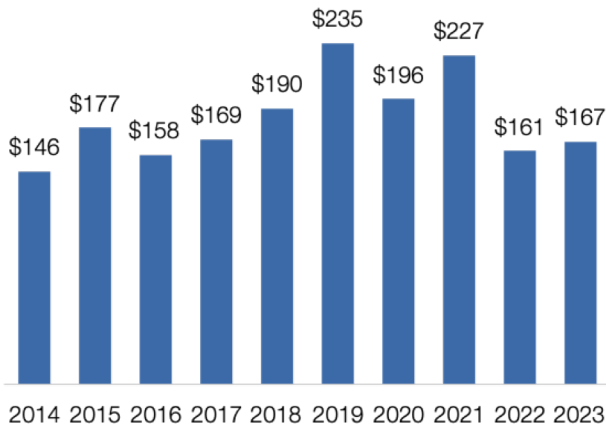

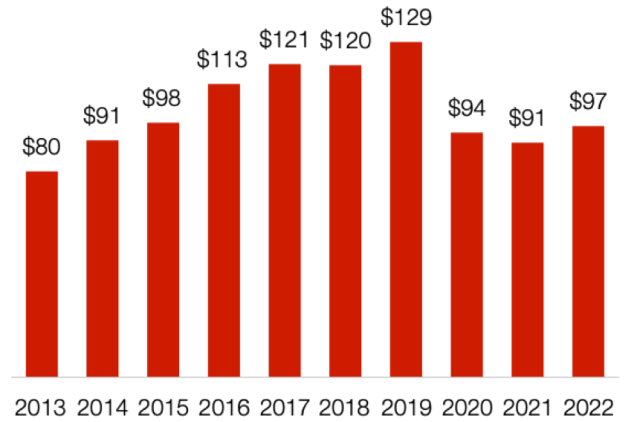

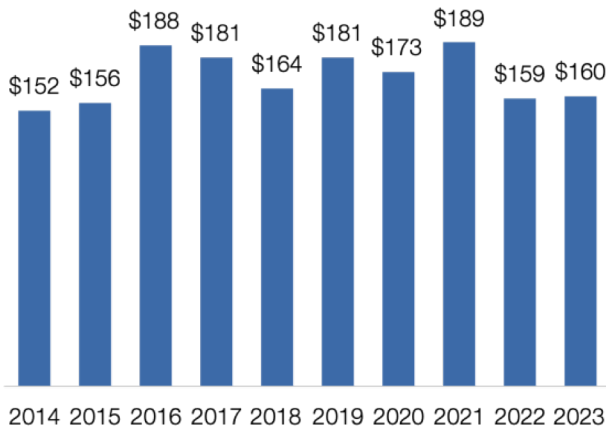

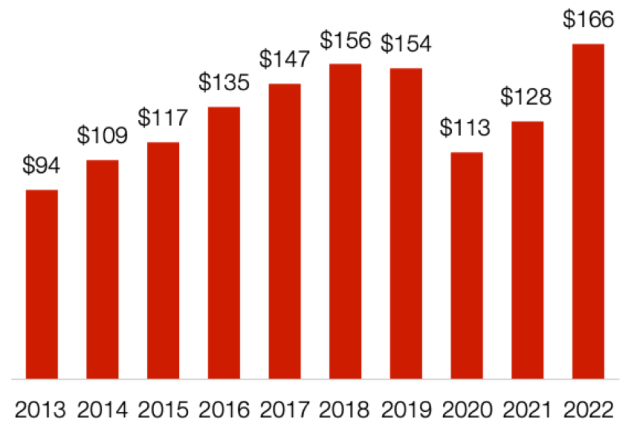

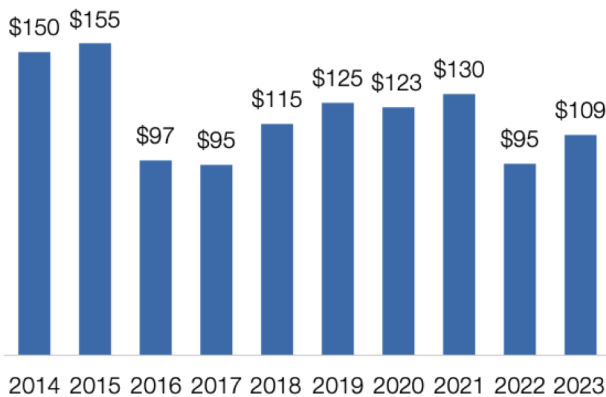

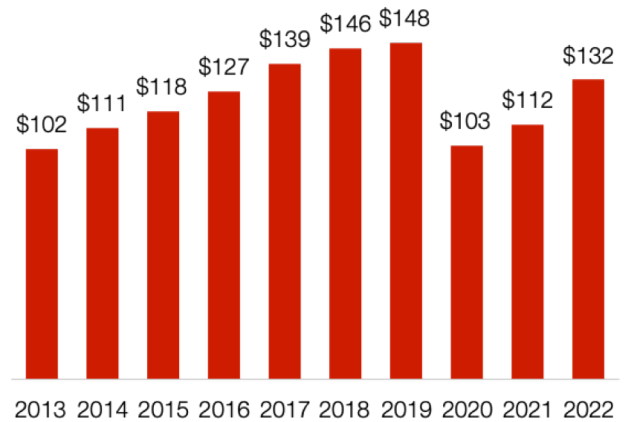

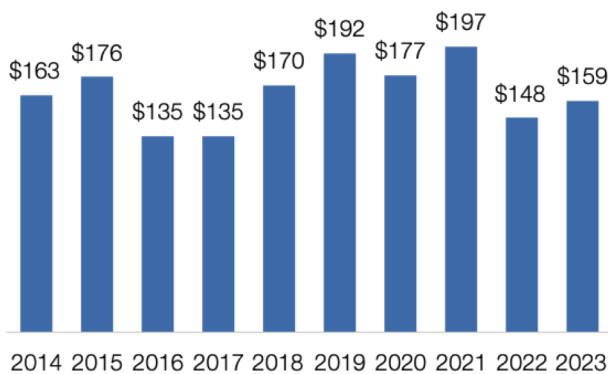

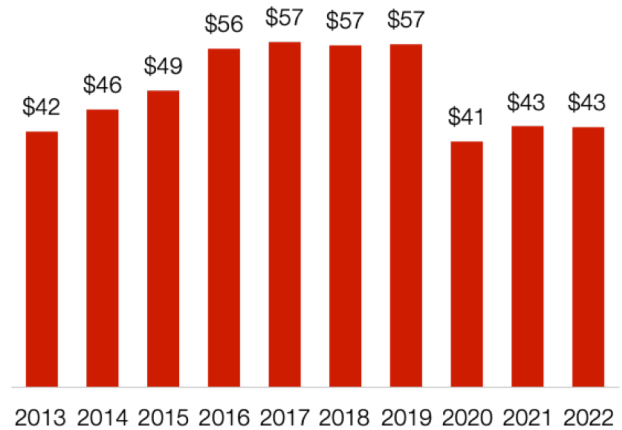
