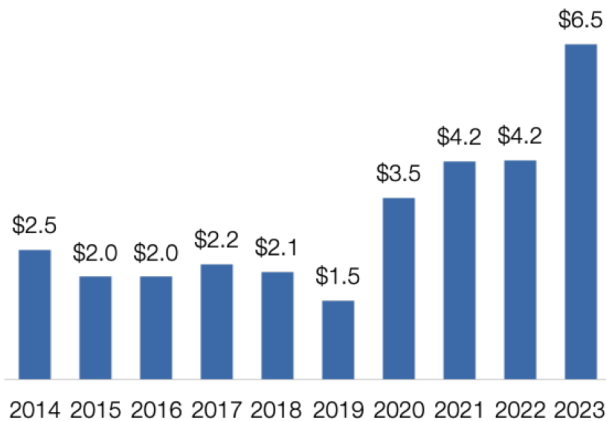


# Louisiana's Exports to China

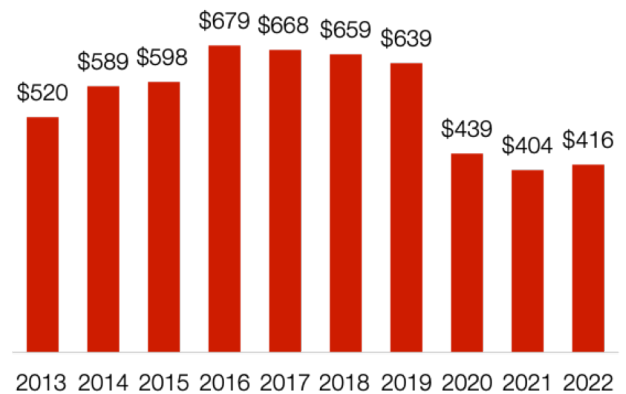
Louisiana's goods and services exports to China supported **14,860** American jobs in 2022.

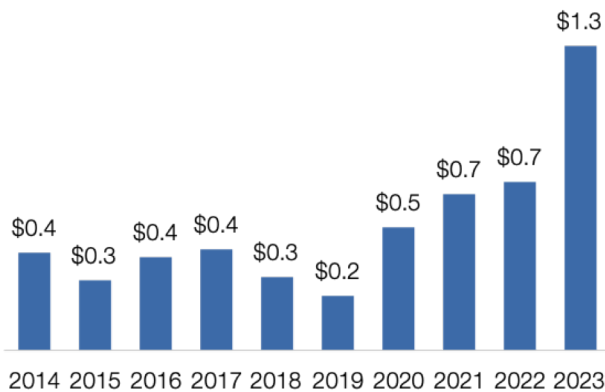

# Louisiana's 3<sup>rd</sup> District Exports to China

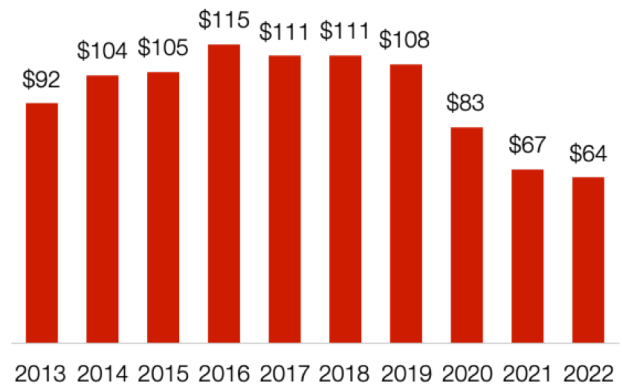
Louisiana's 3<sup>rd</sup> District goods and services exports to China supported **2,580** American jobs in 2022.

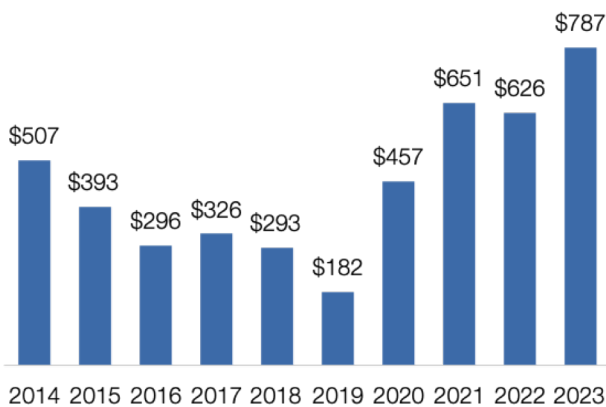

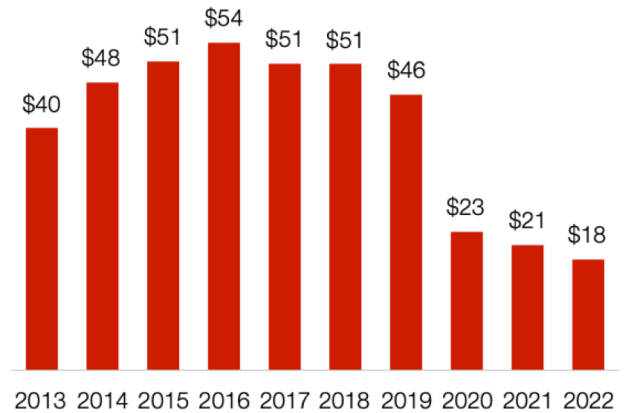

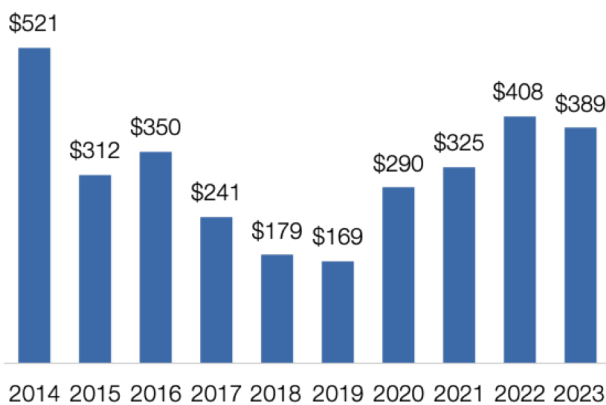

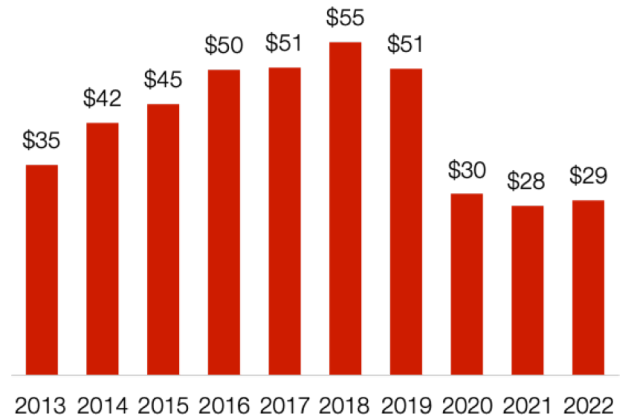

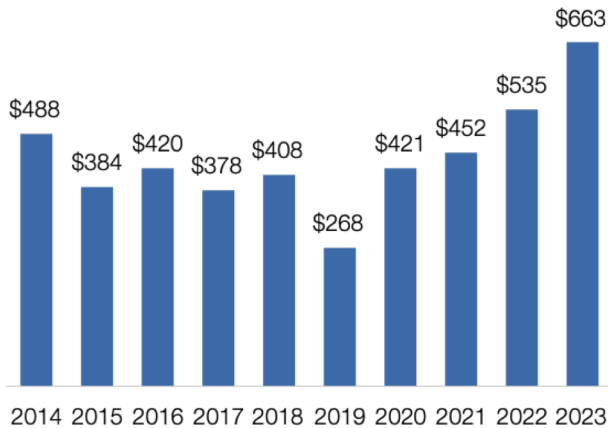

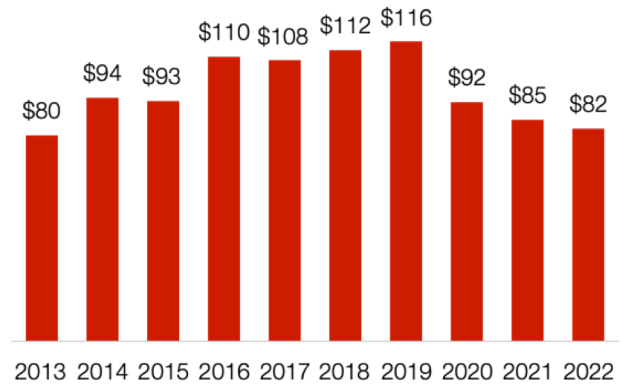
Louisiana's 6<sup>th</sup> District goods and services exports to China supported **2,130** American jobs in 2022.
