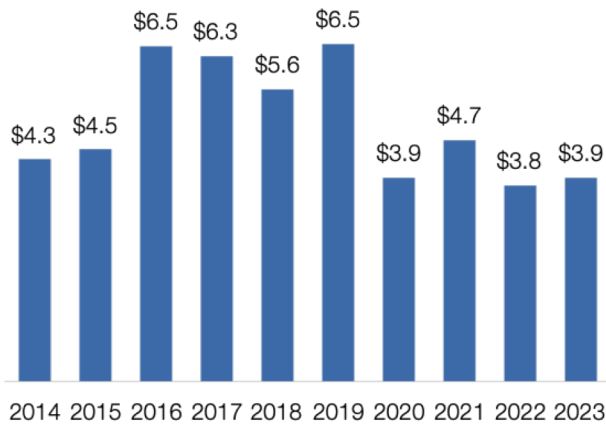


South Carolina's Exports to China

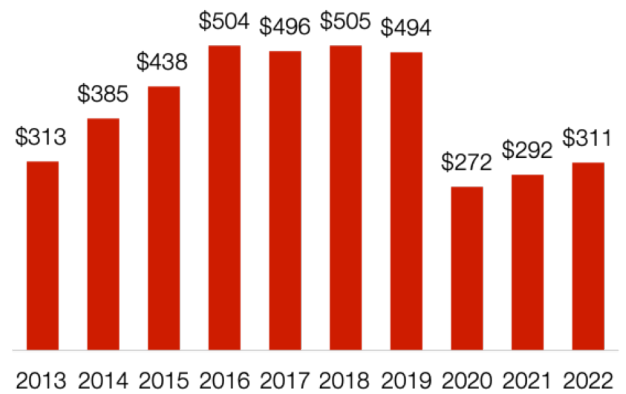
South Carolina's goods and services exports to China supported **18,070** American jobs in 2022.

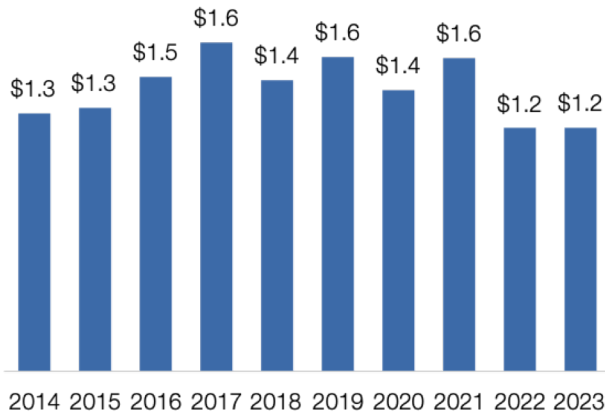

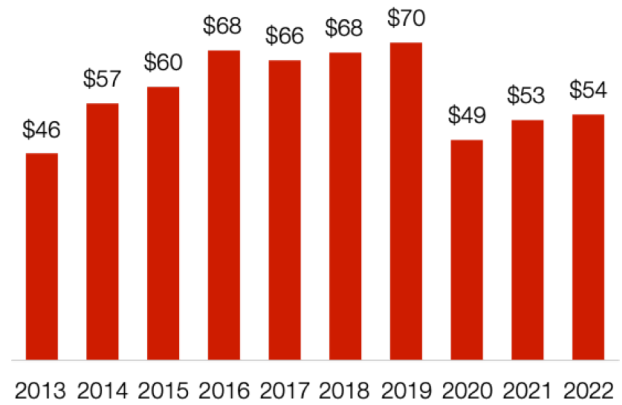
South Carolina's 4th District goods and services exports to China supported **5,230** American jobs in 2022.

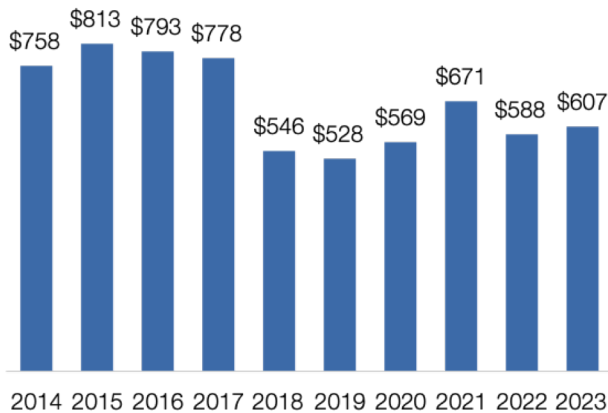

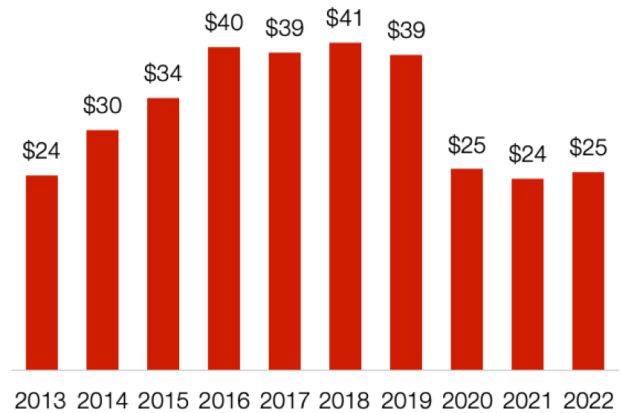

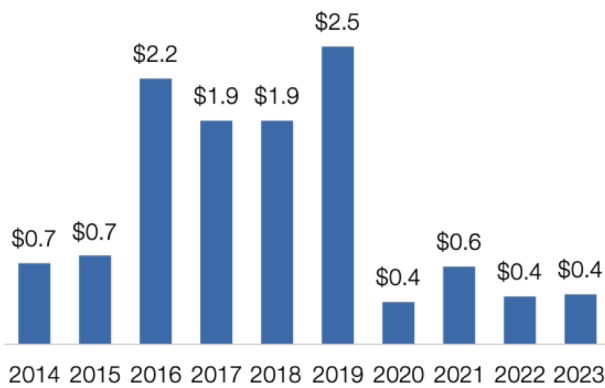

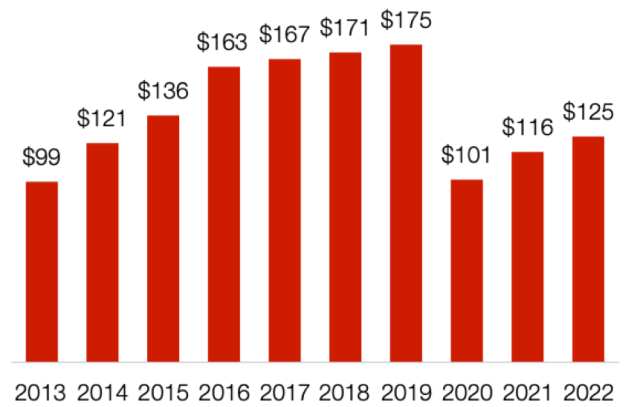

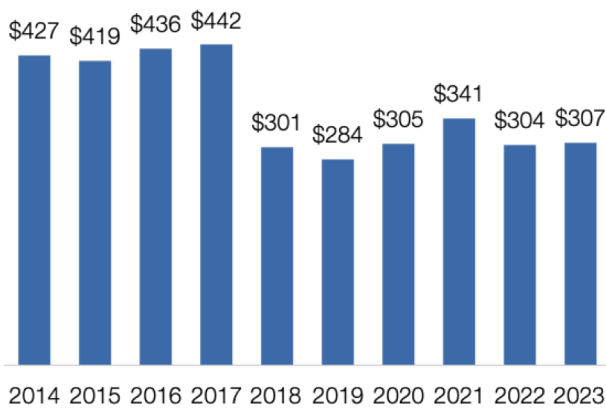

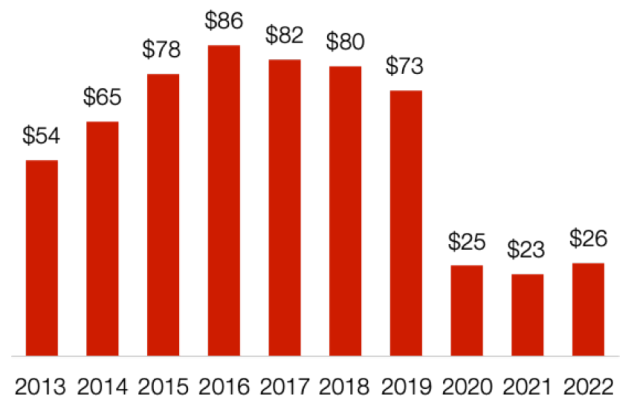
