

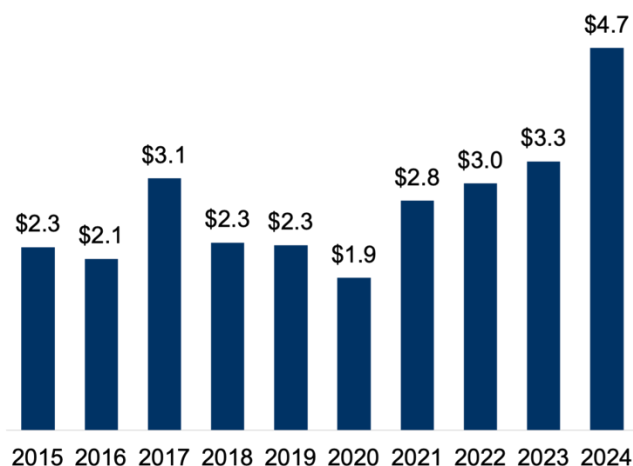
Kentucky's Exports to China

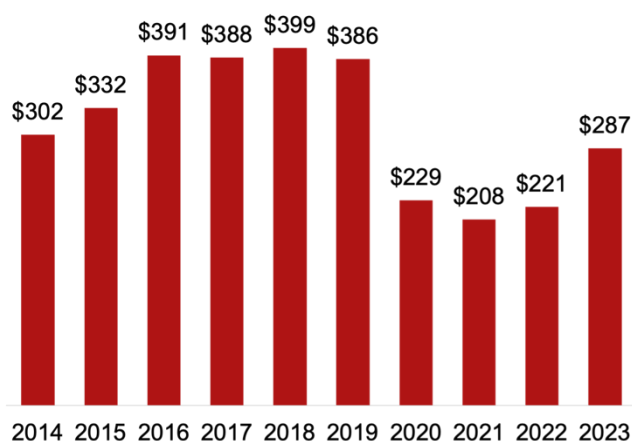

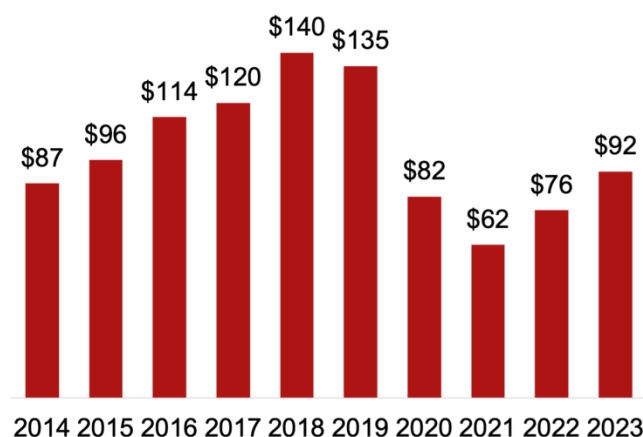

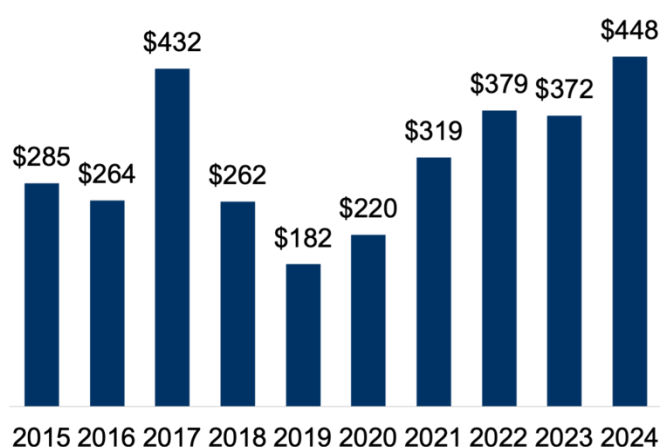

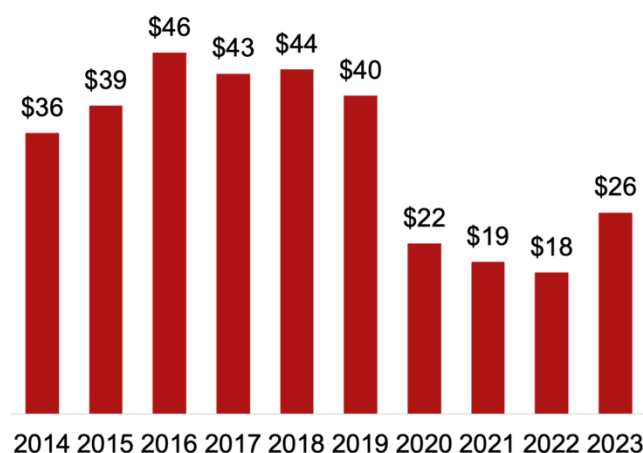

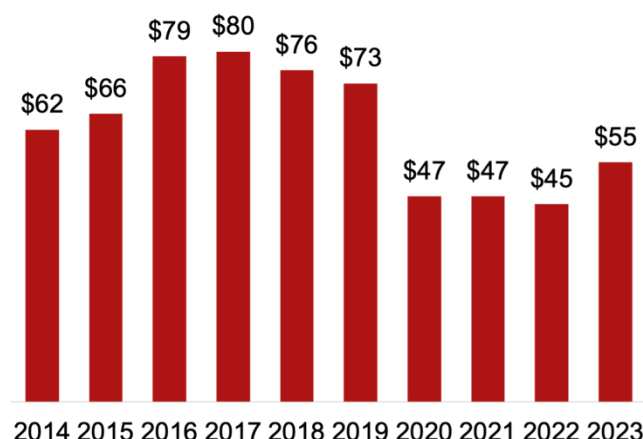

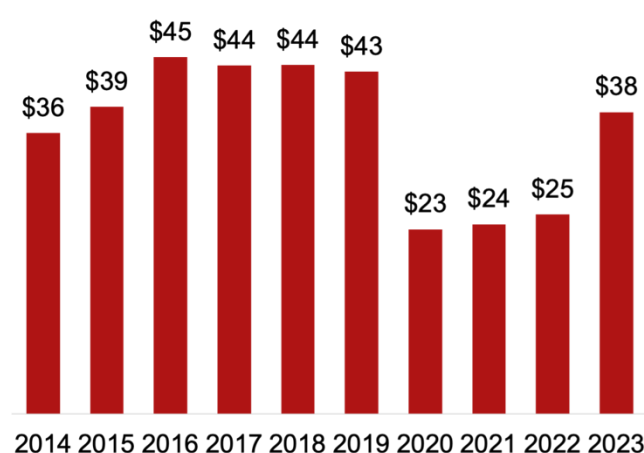

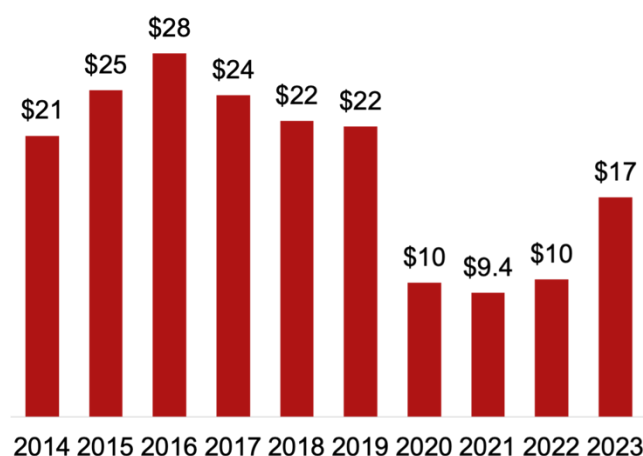

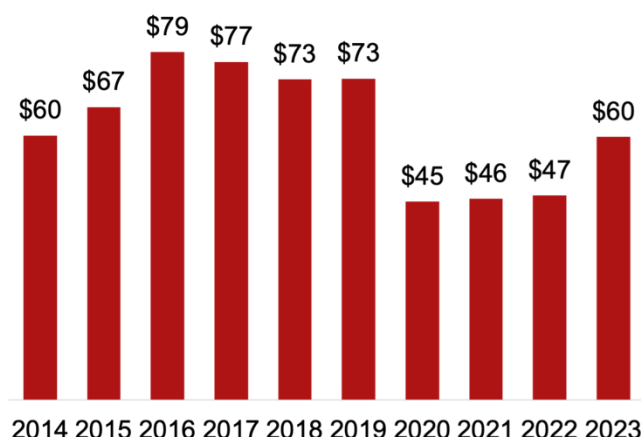
