Nebraska's goods and services exports to China supported **11,550** American jobs in 2023.


Goods (\$ billion)

Nebraska's 1st District goods and services exports to China supported **2,620** American jobs in 2023.


Goods (\$ million)




Nebraska's 2nd District Exports to China

Nebraska's 2nd District goods and services exports to China supported **870** American jobs in 2023.


Goods (\$ million)




Nebraska's 3rd District Exports to China

Nebraska's 3rd District goods and services exports to China supported **8,060** American jobs in 2023.


Goods (\$ billion)
