

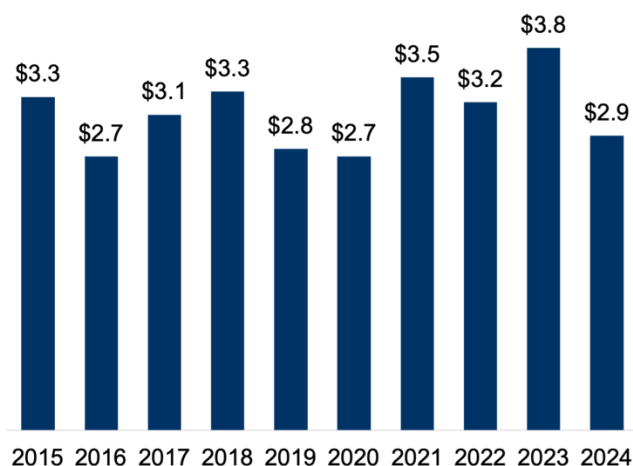
New York's Exports to China

Change (2023-2024): **-23%**

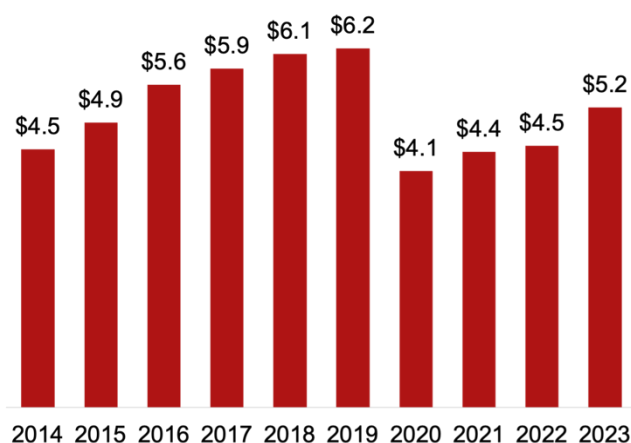


4% of New York's global goods exports went to China in 2024
