




Louisiana's Exports to China

Louisiana's goods and services exports to China supported **15,890** American jobs in 2023.


Goods (\$ billion)




Louisiana's 1st District Exports to China

Louisiana's 1st District goods and services exports to China supported **3,950** American jobs in 2023.


Goods (\$ billions)




Louisiana's 2nd District Exports to China

Louisiana's 2nd District goods and services exports to China supported **3,200** American jobs in 2023.


Goods (\$ billions)








Louisiana's 4th District Exports to China

Louisiana's 4th District goods and services exports to China supported **1,550** American jobs in 2023.





Louisiana's 5th District goods and services exports to China supported **1,540** American jobs in 2023.





Louisiana's 6th District goods and services exports to China supported **1,240** American jobs in 2023.


